## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the medical cannabidiol Act.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 124E.2, subsection 2, paragraphs b and i,
- 2 Code 2019, are amended to read as follows:
- 3 b. Multiple sclerosis with severe and persistent muscle 4 spasms.
- 5 i. Untreatable pain Severe or chronic pain.
- 6 Sec. 2. Section 124E.2, subsection 2, Code 2019, is amended
- 7 by adding the following new paragraphs:
- 8 NEW PARAGRAPH. j. Post-traumatic stress disorder.
- 9 NEW PARAGRAPH. k. Any other medical condition for which
- 10 the patient's health care practitioner determines the use of
- 11 medical cannabidiol could be medically beneficial pursuant to
- 12 rules of the board licensing the health care practitioner.
- 13 Sec. 3. Section 124E.2, subsection 5, Code 2019, is amended
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 5. "Health care practitioner" means an individual licensed
- 16 under chapter 148 to practice medicine and surgery or
- 17 osteopathic medicine and surgery, a physician assistant
- 18 licensed under chapter 148C, or an advanced registered nurse
- 19 practitioner licensed under chapter 152 or 152E, who is a
- 20 patient's primary care provider. "Health care practitioner"
- 21 shall not include a physician assistant licensed under chapter
- 22 148C or an advanced registered nurse practitioner licensed
- 23 pursuant to chapter 152 or 152E.
- 24 Sec. 4. Section 124E.2, subsection 8, Code 2019, is amended
- 25 by striking the subsection.
- Sec. 5. Section 124E.3, subsection 1, Code 2019, is amended
- 27 by adding the following new paragraph:
- 28 NEW PARAGRAPH. c. For a certification issued under section
- 29 124E.2, subsection 2, paragraph "k", determine whether the
- 30 certification would comply with rules of the board licensing
- 31 the health care practitioner, and if so, provide written
- 32 documentation to that effect to the patient.
- 33 Sec. 6. Section 124E.4, subsection 1, Code 2019, is amended
- 34 to read as follows:
- 35 l. a. Issuance to patient. Subject Except as otherwise

- 1 provided in paragraph "b", and subject to subsection
- 2 7, the department may approve the issuance of issue a
- 3 medical cannabidiol registration card by the department of
- 4 transportation to a patient who:
- 5  $a_r$  (1) Is at least eighteen years of age.
- 6  $\frac{b}{c}$  (2) Is a permanent resident of this state.
- 7  $e_{-}$  (3) Submits a written certification to the department
- 8 signed by the patient's health care practitioner that the
- 9 patient is suffering from a debilitating medical condition.
- 10  $d_{r}$  (4) Submits an application to the department, on a form
- 11 created by the department, in consultation with the department
- 12 of transportation, that contains all of the following:
- 13 (1) (a) The patient's full name, Iowa residence address,
- 14 date of birth, and telephone number.
- 15 (2) (b) A copy of the patient's valid photograph
- 16 identification.
- 17 (c) Full name, address, and telephone number of the
- 18 patient's health care practitioner.
- 19 (4) (d) Full name, residence address, date of birth, and
- 20 telephone number of each primary caregiver of the patient, if
- 21 any.
- 22 (5) (e) Any other information required by rule.
- 23  $e_r$  (5) Submits a medical cannabidiol registration card
- 24 fee of one hundred dollars to the department. If the patient
- 25 attests to receiving social security disability benefits,
- 26 supplemental security insurance payments, or being enrolled in
- 27 the medical assistance program, the fee shall be twenty-five
- 28 dollars.
- 29 f. Has not been convicted of a disqualifying felony offense.
- 30 b. Issuance to hospice patient. Notwithstanding the
- 31 requirements of paragraph "a", and subject to subsection 7,
- 32 the department may issue a medical cannabidiol registration
- 33 card to a patient who provides documentation to the department,
- 34 on a form prescribed by the department, that the patient is
- 35 receiving inpatient hospice care in this state.

- 1 Sec. 7. Section 124E.4, subsection 2, unnumbered paragraph
- 2 1, Code 2019, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 A medical cannabidiol registration card issued to a patient
- 4 by the department of transportation pursuant to subsection 1
- 5 shall contain, at a minimum, all of the following:
- 6 Sec. 8. Section 124E.4, subsection 3, unnumbered paragraph
- 7 1, Code 2019, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 For a patient in a primary caregiver's care, subject to
- 9 subsection 7, the department may approve the issuance of issue
- 10 a medical cannabidiol registration card by the department of
- 11 transportation to the primary caregiver who:
- 12 Sec. 9. Section 124E.4, subsection 3, paragraph b,
- 13 unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2019, is amended to read as
- 14 follows:
- 15 Submits an application to the department, on a form created
- 16 by the department, in consultation with the department of
- 17 transportation, that contains all of the following:
- 18 Sec. 10. Section 124E.4, subsection 4, unnumbered paragraph
- 19 1, Code 2019, is amended to read as follows:
- 20 A medical cannabidiol registration card issued by the
- 21 department of transportation to a primary caregiver pursuant to
- 22 subsection 3 shall contain, at a minimum, all of the following:
- 23 Sec. 11. Section 124E.4, subsection 6, Code 2019, is amended
- 24 by striking the subsection.
- 25 Sec. 12. Section 124E.5, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code
- 26 2019, is amended to read as follows:
- 27 a. A medical cannabidiol board is created consisting of
- 28 eight practitioners representing the fields of neurology, pain
- 29 management, gastroenterology, oncology, psychiatry, pediatrics,
- 30 family medicine, and pharmacy, and one representative from law
- 31 enforcement, and two patients with valid medical cannabidiol
- 32 registration cards.
- 33 Sec. 13. Section 124E.5, subsection 2, Code 2019, is amended
- 34 to read as follows:
- 35 2. The medical cannabidiol board shall convene at least

- 1 twice but no more than four eight times per year.
- 2 Sec. 14. Section 124E.7, Code 2019, is amended by adding the
- 3 following new subsections:
- 4 NEW SUBSECTION. 13. A medical cannabidiol manufacturer
- 5 may deliver medical cannabidiol to a patient at the patient's
- 6 residence pursuant to rules of the department.
- 7 NEW SUBSECTION. 14. A medical cannabidiol manufacturer
- 8 shall neutralize plant material waste through the application
- 9 of a chemical such as bleach prior to transporting such plant
- 10 material waste to an approved solid waste disposal facility.
- 11 Sec. 15. Section 124E.11, subsection 1, paragraph b,
- 12 subparagraph (1), subparagraph division (a), Code 2019, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 (a) To authorized employees or agents of the department and
- 15 the department of transportation as necessary to perform the
- 16 duties of the department and the department of transportation
- 17 pursuant to this chapter.
- 18 Sec. 16. Section 124E.11, subsection 2, paragraph i, Code
- 19 2019, is amended to read as follows:
- 20 i. Establish and implement a medical cannabidiol inventory
- 21 and delivery tracking system to track medical cannabidiol
- 22 from production by a medical cannabidiol manufacturer through
- 23 dispensing at a medical cannabidiol dispensary or delivery to a
- 24 patient at the patient's Iowa residence.
- 25 Sec. 17. Section 124E.11, subsection 2, Code 2019, is
- 26 amended by adding the following new paragraph:
- 27 NEW PARAGRAPH. j. Establish the circumstances under
- 28 which a medical cannabidiol manufacturer may deliver medical
- 29 cannabidiol to a patient at the patient's Iowa residence.
- 30 Sec. 18. Section 124E.12, subsection 6, Code 2019, is
- 31 amended to read as follows:
- 32 6. The department, the department of transportation, and
- 33 any health care practitioner person licensed, registered, or
- 34 certified by an entity listed in section 272C.1, including any
- 35 authorized agent or employee thereof, are not subject to any

- 1 civil or disciplinary penalties by the board of medicine or
- 2 any business, occupational, or professional licensing board or
- 3 entity, solely for activities conducted relating to a patient's
- 4 possession or use of medical cannabidiol as authorized under
- 5 this chapter. Such an entity shall not subject a licensed,
- 6 registered, or certified person to discipline relating to
- 7 a patient's possession or use of medical cannabidiol as
- 8 authorized under this chapter. Nothing in this section affects
- 9 a professional licensing board from taking action in response
- 10 to violations of any other section of law.
- 11 Sec. 19. Section 124E.12, subsection 7, Code 2019, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 7. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the department,
- 14 the department of transportation, the governor, or any employee
- 15 of any state agency shall not be held civilly or criminally
- 16 liable for any injury, loss of property, personal injury, or
- 17 death caused by any act or omission while acting within the
- 18 scope of office or employment as authorized under this chapter.
- 19 Sec. 20. Section 423.3, Code 2019, is amended by adding the
- 20 following new subsection:
- 21 NEW SUBSECTION. 107. The sales price of any medical
- 22 cannabidiol product sold by a medical cannabidiol manufacturer
- 23 or a medical cannabidiol dispensary pursuant to chapter 124E.
- 24 Sec. 21. TRANSITION PROVISIONS. A medical cannabidiol
- 25 registration card issued prior to July 1, 2019, remains
- 26 effective and continues in effect as issued for the
- 27 twelve-month period following its issuance.
- 28 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 31 This bill relates to the medical cannabidiol Act.
- 32 The bill amends the definition of debilitating medical
- 33 condition by removing the requirement that multiple sclerosis
- 34 be accompanied by severe and persistent muscle spasms,
- 35 replacing untreatable pain with severe or chronic pain,

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- 1 and adding post-traumatic stress disorder to the list of
- 2 conditions which allow a patient to be certified by a health
- 3 care practitioner to receive a medical cannabidiol registration
- 4 card. The bill also allows a health care practitioner to
- 5 certify a patient to receive a medical cannabidiol registration
- 6 card for any other medical condition for which the health care
- 7 practitioner determines the use of medical cannabidiol would be
- 8 medically beneficial, pursuant to rules of the board licensing
- 9 the health care practitioner, and provide written documentation
- 10 to that effect to the patient.
- 11 The bill amends the definition of a health care practitioner
- 12 to allow a licensed physician assistant and a licensed advanced
- 13 registered nurse practitioner to certify a patient to receive a
- 14 medical cannabidiol registration card.
- The bill allows the department of public health to issue a
- 16 medical cannabidiol registration card to a patient receiving
- 17 inpatient hospice care in Iowa without complying with any other
- 18 requirement to receive a medical cannabidiol registration card
- 19 after producing proof that the patient is receiving hospice
- 20 care. The bill also removes the restriction on certain felons
- 21 receiving medical cannabidiol patient registration cards.
- 22 The bill amends the membership of the medical cannabidiol
- 23 board by adding two members who are patients with valid medical
- 24 cannabidiol registration cards. The bill also allows the board
- 25 to meet up to eight times per year.
- 26 The bill allows medical cannabidiol manufacturers to make
- 27 deliveries to patients pursuant to rules of the board. The
- 28 bill requires medical cannabidiol manufacturers to neutralize
- 29 plant waste with a chemical such as bleach before transporting
- 30 such waste to a solid waste disposal site. Currently, such
- 31 material must be composted prior to transportation pursuant to
- 32 rules of the department.
- 33 The bill prohibits any licensing board from disciplining a
- 34 person licensed, certified, or registered by that licensing

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35 board for conducting activities related to a patient's

- 1 certification to purchase and consume medical cannabidiol or
- 2 for purchasing and consuming medical cannabidiol.
- 3 The bill exempts sales of medical cannabidiol products by
- 4 a medical cannabidiol manufacturer or a medical cannabidiol
- 5 dispensary pursuant to Code chapter 124E from sales tax.
- 6 The bill removes the department of transportation from the
- 7 process of issuing medical cannabidiol registration cards.
- 8 The bill provides that any medical cannabidiol registration
- 9 card issued by the department of transportation prior to July
- 10 1, 2019, remains in effect and continues in effect for the
- 11 12-month period following its issuance. The bill requires
- 12 the department of public health to issue medical cannabidiol
- 13 registration cards.
