A BILL FOR

1 An Act providing for a chief operations officer within the
2 office of the governor.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 7.19 Chief operations officer.

2 The governor shall appoint, subject to confirmation by
3 the senate, a chief operations officer who shall be a part
4 of the governor's staff and who shall serve at the pleasure
5 of the governor. The chief operations officer shall provide
6 operational management and leadership of state government
7 agencies to ensure the agencies are functioning effectively and
8 efficiently.

EXPLANATION

10 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
11 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

12 This bill provides that the governor shall appoint a chief
13 operations officer within the office of the governor subject to
14 confirmation by the senate. The bill provides that the chief
15 operations officer shall provide operational management and
16 leadership of state government agencies.
