A BILL FOR

1 An Act repealing statewide registration requirements for
2 interior designers.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 546.10, subsection 1, paragraph f, Code
2 2019, is amended by striking the paragraph.

3 Sec. 2. Section 546.10, subsection 5, Code 2019, is amended
4 to read as follows:

5 5. Fees collected under chapters 542, 542B, 543B, 544A,
6 and 544B, and ~~544C~~ shall be paid to the treasurer of state
7 and credited to the general fund of the state. All expenses
8 required in the discharge of the duties and responsibilities
9 imposed upon the professional licensing and regulation bureau
10 of the banking division of the department of commerce, the
11 administrator, and the licensing boards by the laws of this
12 state shall be paid from moneys appropriated by the general
13 assembly for those purposes. All fees deposited into the
14 general fund of the state, as provided in this subsection,
15 shall be subject to the requirements of section 8.60.

16 Sec. 3. REPEAL. Chapter 544C, Code 2019, is repealed.

17 Sec. 4. DISPOSITION OF REGISTRATION FEES. All registration
18 fees collected under chapter 544C shall be prorated to June 30,
19 2019, and that portion of the registration fee that represents
20 the remaining period of the registrant, following June 30,
21 2019, shall be returned to the registrant.

22 EXPLANATION

23 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
24 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

25 This bill repeals Code chapter 544C, providing for statewide
26 registration of interior designers by the interior design
27 examining board. The bill makes conforming changes by removing
28 references to Code chapter 544C within Code chapter 546.

29 The bill provides that all registration fees collected shall
30 be prorated to June 30, 2019, and that the portion of the
31 registration fee that represents the remaining period of the
32 registrant, following June 30, 2019, shall be returned to the
33 registrant.
