**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to newborn metabolic screening to include all  
2 disorders listed on the recommended uniform screening panel  
3 recommended by the United States department of health and  
4 human services.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 136A.5, subsection 1, Code 2019, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 1. All newborns born in this state shall be screened for  
4 congenital and inherited disorders in accordance with rules  
5 adopted by the department. The rules adopted shall provide  
6 for screening, at a minimum, for all core conditions listed  
7 on the recommended uniform screening panel recommended by  
8 the secretary of the United States department of health and  
9 human services advisory committee on heritable disorders in  
10 newborns and children. The department shall expand the newborn  
11 metabolic screening panel to include, no later than January 1,  
12 2020, Mucopolysaccharidosis type 1, Glycogen storage disease  
13 type II (Pompe), X-linked Adrenoleukodystrophy, and any other  
14 lysosomal storage disorder listed on the recommended uniform  
15 screening panel as of July 1, 2019.

16 EXPLANATION

17 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
18 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

19 This bill directs the department of public health to adopt  
20 rules to include in the newborn metabolic screening, at a  
21 minimum, all core conditions listed on the recommended uniform  
22 screening panel (RUSP) recommended by the secretary of the  
23 United States department of health and human services advisory  
24 committee on heritable disorders in newborns and children  
25 (SACHDNC). The bill also directs the department specifically,  
26 not later than January 1, 2020, to expand the newborn  
27 metabolic screening panel to include Mucopolysaccharidosis  
28 type 1, Glycogen storage disease type II (Pompe), X-linked  
29 Adrenoleukodystrophy, and any other lysosomal storage disorder  
30 listed on the RUSP as of July 1, 2019. The RUSP currently  
31 includes 34 core conditions and 26 secondary conditions for  
32 which the SACHDNC recommends every newborn should be screened.  
33 Iowa currently screens for 31 of the 34 core conditions listed  
34 on the RUSP.
