A BILL FOR

- $\ensuremath{\mathbf{1}}$ An Act relating to the practice of massage therapy, and
- providing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 152C.5, Code 2019, is amended to read as 2 follows:
- 3 152C.5 Practice or use of title license required.
- 4 The practice of massage therapy as defined in section
- 5 152C.1 is strictly prohibited by unlicensed individuals. It
- 6 is unlawful a serious misdemeanor for a person to engage in or
- 7 offer to engage in the practice of massage therapy, or use in
- 8 connection with the person's name, the initials "L.M.T." or
- 9 the words "licensed massage therapist", "massage therapist",
- 10 "masseur", "masseuse", or any other word or title that implies
- 11 or represents that the person practices massage therapy, unless
- 12 the person possesses a license issued under the provisions of
- 13 section 152C.3.
- 14 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 152C.10 Enforcement.
- 15 A political subdivision of the state shall not enact or
- 16 enforce any restrictions or requirements concerning massage
- 17 therapists and the practice of massage therapy that are
- 18 inconsistent with the provisions of this chapter.
- 19 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 22 This bill makes the practice of massage therapy or the use
- 23 of titles associated with massage therapists by an unlicensed
- 24 individual a serious misdemeanor. A serious misdemeanor is
- 25 punishable by confinement for no more than one year and a fine
- 26 of at least \$315 but not more than \$1,875. The bill also
- 27 prohibits political subdivisions of the state from enacting or
- 28 enforcing restrictions on massage therapy or massage therapists
- 29 that are not contained in Code chapter 152C.
