

**Senate Study Bill 3065 - Introduced**

**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act limiting authority of cities and counties to require a  
2 license or permit for businesses operated by minors.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 331.301, Code 2020, is amended by adding  
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 18. A county shall not adopt an ordinance,  
4 motion, resolution, or amendment imposing any requirement to  
5 obtain a permit or license for a business operated for no more  
6 than eighty-four days in a calendar year by a person or persons  
7 under the age of eighteen.

8 Sec. 2. Section 364.3, Code 2020, is amended by adding the  
9 following new subsection:

10 NEW SUBSECTION. 13. A city shall not adopt or enforce  
11 an ordinance imposing any requirement to obtain a permit or  
12 license for a business operated on an occasional basis for no  
13 more than eighty-four days in a calendar year by a person or  
14 persons under the age of eighteen.

15 EXPLANATION

16 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
17 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

18 This bill limits the authority of a county or city to adopt  
19 an ordinance imposing a requirement to obtain a permit or  
20 license for a business operated for no more than 84 days in a  
21 calendar year by a person or persons under the age of 18.
