

**Senate Study Bill 3090 - Introduced**

**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act eliminating the board of dietetics and license  
2 requirements for dietitians, and including transition  
3 provisions.  
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 147.1, subsection 6, Code 2020, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 6. "*Profession*" means medicine and surgery, podiatry,  
4 osteopathic medicine and surgery, genetic counseling, practice  
5 as a physician assistant, psychology, chiropractic, nursing,  
6 dentistry, dental hygiene, dental assisting, optometry, speech  
7 pathology, audiology, pharmacy, physical therapy, physical  
8 therapist assisting, occupational therapy, occupational therapy  
9 assisting, respiratory care, cosmetology arts and sciences,  
10 barbering, mortuary science, applied behavior analysis, marital  
11 and family therapy, mental health counseling, polysomnography,  
12 social work, ~~dietetics~~, massage therapy, athletic training,  
13 acupuncture, nursing home administration, practice as a hearing  
14 aid specialist, sign language interpreting or transliterating,  
15 orthotics, prosthetics, or pedorthics.

16 Sec. 2. Section 147.2, subsection 1, Code 2020, is amended  
17 to read as follows:

18 1. A person shall not engage in the practice of medicine  
19 and surgery, podiatry, osteopathic medicine and surgery,  
20 genetic counseling, psychology, chiropractic, physical  
21 therapy, physical therapist assisting, nursing, dentistry,  
22 dental hygiene, dental assisting, optometry, speech pathology,  
23 audiology, occupational therapy, occupational therapy  
24 assisting, orthotics, prosthetics, pedorthics, respiratory  
25 care, pharmacy, cosmetology arts and sciences, barbering,  
26 social work, ~~dietetics~~, applied behavior analysis, marital  
27 and family therapy or mental health counseling, massage  
28 therapy, mortuary science, polysomnography, athletic training,  
29 acupuncture, nursing home administration, or sign language  
30 interpreting or transliterating, or shall not practice as a  
31 physician assistant or a hearing aid specialist, unless the  
32 person has obtained a license for that purpose from the board  
33 for the profession.

34 Sec. 3. Section 147.13, subsection 17, Code 2020, is amended  
35 by striking the subsection.
