HOUSE FILE 127

A BILL FOR

1 An Act prohibiting the manufacture, possession, shipment,
2 transportation, or receipt of a multi-burst trigger
3 activator, and providing penalties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 724.1D Multi-burst trigger
2 activator — penalty.

3 1. As used in this section, *"multi-burst trigger activator"*
4 means a device designed or redesigned to be attached to a
5 semi-automatic firearm that enables a firearm to discharge
6 two or more shots in a burst by activating the device, or a
7 manual or power-driven trigger activating device constructed
8 or designed to increase the rate of fire of a semi-automatic
9 firearm when attached. A multi-burst trigger activator
10 includes firearm accessories, parts, and a combination of parts
11 that significantly increase a semi-automatic firearm's rate
12 of fire beyond the standard rate of fire for a semi-automatic
13 firearm.

14 2. A person shall not manufacture, possess, ship,
15 transport, or receive a multi-burst trigger activator.

16 3. A person who violates subsection 2 commits a class "D"
17 felony.

18 EXPLANATION

19 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
20 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

21 This bill prohibits the manufacture, possession, shipment,
22 transportation, or receipt of a multi-burst trigger activator.

23 The bill defines a multi-burst trigger activator to
24 mean a device designed or redesigned to be attached to a
25 semi-automatic firearm that enables a firearm to discharge
26 two or more shots in a burst by activating the device, or a
27 manual or power-driven trigger activating device constructed
28 or designed to increase the rate of fire of a semi-automatic
29 firearm when attached. A multi-burst trigger activator
30 includes firearm accessories, parts, and a combination of parts
31 that significantly increase a semi-automatic firearm's rate
32 of fire beyond the standard rate of fire for a semi-automatic
33 firearm.

34 A person who violates the bill commits a class "D" felony.
35 A class "D" felony is punishable by confinement for no more

1 than five years and a fine of at least \$1,025 but not more than
2 \$10,245.
