## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act establishing the advanced dyslexia specialist
- 2 endorsement grant program.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## H.F. 2185

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **261.109 Advanced dyslexia** 2 specialist endorsement grant program.
- 3 l. If moneys are appropriated by the general assembly
- 4 for a fiscal year for the purpose provided in this section,
- 5 the college student aid commission, in collaboration with
- 6 the department of education, shall develop and administer
- 7 a grant program to provide grants to teachers to obtain an
- 8 advanced dyslexia specialist endorsement pursuant to section
- 9 272.2, subsection 23, to help offset the cost associated with
- 10 obtaining the advanced dyslexia specialist endorsement.
- 11 2. The college student aid commission shall establish the
- 12 evaluation criteria to be used in evaluating applications for
- 13 grants submitted under this section. Priority shall be given
- 14 to applicants who are residents of Iowa and to applicants who
- 15 graduated from an institution of higher learning governed by
- 16 the state board of regents or an accredited private institution
- 17 as defined in section 261.9.
- 18 3. The college student aid commission, in collaboration
- 19 with the department of education, shall adopt rules pursuant to
- 20 chapter 17A to administer this section.
- 21 4. An advanced dyslexia specialist endorsement grant
- 22 program fund is established in the state treasury. The fund
- 23 shall be administered by the college student aid commission and
- 24 shall consist of moneys appropriated by the general assembly
- 25 and any other moneys received by the college student aid
- 26 commission for deposit in the fund. The moneys in the fund
- 27 are appropriated to the college student aid commission for
- 28 the advanced dyslexia specialist endorsement grant program.
- 29 Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys in the fund at the close
- 30 of the fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund of
- 31 the state but shall remain available for expenditure for the
- 32 advanced dyslexia specialist endorsement grant program for
- 33 subsequent fiscal years. Notwithstanding section 12C.7,
- 34 subsection 2, interest or earnings on moneys in the fund shall
- 35 be credited to the fund.

1	EXPLANATION
2	The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
3	the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
4	This bill establishes the advanced dyslexia specialist
5	endorsement grant program.
6	The bill requires the college student aid commission
7	(commission), in collaboration with the department of education $\ensuremath{S}$
8	(department), to develop and administer a grant program to
9	provide grants to teachers to obtain an advanced dyslexia
10	specialist endorsement pursuant to Code section 272.2(23), to
11	help offset the cost associated with obtaining the endorsement,
12	if moneys are appropriated by the general assembly for a fiscal
13	year for this purpose.
14	The bill requires the commission to establish the criteria
15	to be used when evaluating applications for grants submitted
16	under the advanced dyslexia specialist endorsement grant
17	program. The bill also requires the commission to give
18	priority to applicants who are residents of Iowa and to
19	applicants who graduated from an institution of higher learning
20	governed by the state board of regents or an accredited private
21	institution.
22	The bill requires the commission, in collaboration with the
23	department, to adopt rules to administer the advanced dyslexia
24	specialist endorsement grant program.
25	The bill establishes an advanced dyslexia specialist
26	endorsement grant program fund in the state treasury.
