A BILL FOR

1 An Act requiring the department of natural resources to develop
2 a plan to match the nationally determined commitment to cut
3 greenhouse gas pollution.
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NATIONALLY DETERMINED COMMITMENT TO CUT
2 GREENHOUSE GAS POLLUTION. The director of the department of
3 natural resources shall work with representatives from the
4 department of transportation, the department of agriculture
5 and land stewardship, the economic development authority, and
6 the utilities board of the department of commerce to develop
7 a plan to match the nationally determined commitment to
8 achieve a fifty to fifty-two percent reduction from 2005 levels
9 in economy-wide net greenhouse gas pollution by 2030. The
10 department of natural resources shall submit the plan to the
11 general assembly no later than December 31, 2022.

12 EXPLANATION

13 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
14 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

15 This bill requires the director of the department of
16 natural resources (DNR) to work with representatives from the
17 department of transportation, the department of agriculture and
18 land stewardship, the economic development authority, and the
19 utilities board of the department of commerce to develop a plan
20 to match the nationally determined commitment to achieve a 50
21 to 52 percent reduction from 2005 levels in economy-wide net
22 greenhouse gas pollution by 2030. DNR shall submit the plan to
23 the general assembly no later than December 31, 2022.
