- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1.18, subsection 1, paragraph b, Code 2 2022, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 b. Throughout the history of Iowa and of the United States,
- 4 the common thread binding individuals of differing backgrounds
- 5 together has been the English language and any other language
- 6 deemed necessary to achieve the purposes of the state of Iowa
- 7 and the political subdivisions of the state.
- 8 EXPLANATION
- 9 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 10 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 11 This bill amends Code section 1.18, regarding Iowa English
- 12 language reaffirmation, to provide that the general assembly
- 13 declares that the common thread binding individuals in the
- 14 state includes, in addition to the English language, any other
- 15 language deemed necessary to achieve the purposes of the state.
