- 6 characteristics of a dog. This subsection does not inhibit
- 7 the authority of a county to adopt, enforce, or administer an
- 8 ordinance, motion, resolution, or amendment that applies to all
- 9 dogs.
- 10 Sec. 2. Section 364.3, Code 2022, is amended by adding the
- 11 following new subsection:
- 12 NEW SUBSECTION. 17. A city shall not adopt, enforce,
- 13 or otherwise administer an ordinance, motion, resolution,
- 14 or amendment that is specific to the breed or physical
- 15 characteristics of a dog. This subsection does not inhibit
- 16 the authority of a city to adopt, enforce, or administer an
- 17 ordinance, motion, resolution, or amendment that applies to all
- 18 dogs.
- 19 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 22 This bill prohibits counties and cities from adopting,
- 23 enforcing, or administering an ordinance, motion, resolution,

- 25 of a dog. The bill does not inhibit the authority of a county
- 26 or city to adopt, enforce, or administer an ordinance, motion,
- 27 resolution, or amendment that applies to all dogs.
