- penalties applicable.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 68A.303, subsection 1, paragraphs b and 2 e, Code 2022, are amended to read as follows:
- 3 b. Contributions to national, state, or local political
- 4 party central committees, or to partisan political committees 5 organized to represent persons within the boundaries of a
- 6 congressional district, but only as reimbursement for goods
- 7 transferred or services rendered to the candidate's committee.
- 8 e. Contributions to another candidate's committee when
- 9 the candidate for whom both committees are formed is the same
- 10 person, but only as reimbursement for goods transferred or
- ll services rendered to the candidate's committee.
- 12 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 15 This bill relates to the transfer of campaign funds from
- 16 a candidate's committee. The bill prohibits a candidate's
- 17 committee from transferring campaign funds to national, state,
- 18 or local political party central committees, partisan political
- 19 committees, or a candidate's committee when the candidate for
- 20 whom both committees are formed is the same person, except as
- 21 reimbursement for goods transferred or services rendered to the
- 22 candidate's committee.
- 23 By operation of law, a person who violates a provision of the
- 24 bill is guilty of a serious misdemeanor. A serious misdemeanor
- 25 is punishable by confinement for no more than one year and a
- 26 fine of at least \$430 but not more than \$2,560.
