## House File 2312 - Introduced

## A BILL FOR

1 An Act providing for the filling of a vacancy in the office of 2 commissioner of soil and water conservation districts. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section l. Section l61A.5, subsection 2, Code 2022, is amended to read as follows:
2. a. The governing body of each district shall consist of five commissioners elected on a nonpartisan basis for staggered four-year terms commencing on the first day of January that is not a Sunday or holiday following their election.
b. Any eligible elector residing in the district is eligible to the office of commissioner, except that not more than two commissioners shall at any one time be a resident of any one township. A vacancy is ereated in the office of any eommissioner who changes residence into a township where two eommissioners then reside.
e. If a commissionex is absent for sixty or more percent of monthly meetings during any twelve-month period, the other eommigsioners by their unanimous vote may declare the member's office vacant. A vacancy in the office of commisgioner shall
be filled by appointment of the committee until the next
suceeding general election, at which time the balance of the unexpired term shall be filled as provided by section 69.12.

Sec. 2. Section l6lA.5, Code 2022, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 4. a. A vacancy in the office of commissioner of a district shall be filled by a person appointed by the committee.
b. The commission shall declare a vacancy in the office of commissioner not later than thirty days after the vacancy occurs. The vacancy may be based on a commissioner's death or the commission's acceptance of the commissioner's resignation. A vacancy is created when a commissioner changes residence into a township where two commissioners then reside. If a commissioner is absent for sixty percent or more of monthly meetings during any twelve-month period, the other commissioners by unanimous vote may declare the member's office vacant.
c. The commissioners shall publish notice of the vacancy in

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the district pursuant to section 331.305. The commissioners shall nominate one or more qualified electors residing in the district to the committee. The commissioners shall make the nominations in open session as provided in chapter 21. The commissioners shall consider representation on the commission that reflects the diversity of the district's population. The commissioners shall accept applications from eligible electors residing in the district. Not earlier than thirty days after the notice of the vacancy was first published, the commissioners shall submit to the committee a list and qualifications of eligible electors residing in the district who are nominated by the commissioners and applicants who submitted timely applications to the commissioners.
$d$. The committee shall review the lists of all nominees and applicants in open session as provided in chapter 21. The committee shall place consideration of the appointment on the published agenda of the next regularly scheduled meeting of the committee following receipt of nominations and applications. The committee shall make all decisions regarding an appointment in open session as provided in chapter 2l. The committee shall consider representation on the commission that reflects the diversity of the district's population.
$e$. The vacancy shall be filled until the next succeeding general election, at which time the balance of the unexpired term shall be filled as provided by section 69.12.

BACKGROUND. This bill amends provisions in Code chapter l6lA, known as the "soil conservation districts law" (Code section l6lA.l), established within the jurisdiction of the department of agriculture and land stewardship (DALS). There are 100 soil and water conservation districts (districts) (Code section l6lA.5(l)). The governing body of a district consists of five commissioners elected on a nonpartisan

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$l l$ the committee until the next succeeding general election (Code 12 section l61A.5(2)).
13 BILL'S PROVISIONS. The bill requires the commissioners 14 to publish a notice of a vacancy in the district and accept 15 applications from persons interested in being appointed to fill 16 that vacancy. The commissioners must submit to the committee 17 a list of the names and qualifications of one or more persons 18 nominated by the commissioners and any applications that it

basis for staggered four-year terms (Code section l6lA.5(2)). The state soil conservation and water quality committee (committee) consisting of nine governor-appointed members together with DALS' division of soil conservation and water quality oversees the districts and the commissioners for each district (Code section l6lA.4). A vacancy may occur on a commission for various reasons, including when a commissioner changes residence into a township where two commissioners then reside. A vacancy may also occur based on a commissioner's nonattendance. A vacancy is filled by a person appointed by received after publishing the notice. The committee must place consideration of the appointment on the published agenda for the next regularly scheduled meeting of the committee following receipt of the list of nominations and applications. The commissioners and the committee shall make all decisions regarding an appointment in open session under Iowa's open meeting law (Code chapter 2l). The commissioners and the committee must consider representation on the commission population.
