A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to certain political contributions and

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **68A.507 Expenditures and**
- 2 contributions from out-of-state sources prohibited.
- A political committee shall not make an expenditure in
 this state using funds derived from sources outside this state.
- 5 2. A candidate or a candidate's committee shall not accept
- 6 a contribution from a person not living in or incorporated or
- 7 organized under the laws of this state.
- 8 3. The board shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A for 9 the implementation of this section.
- 10 Sec. 2. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **68A.508** Contributions from political 11 committees prohibited.
- 12 A candidate or a candidate's committee shall not accept a 13 contribution from a political committee.
- 14 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 17 This bill relates to certain political contributions and
- 18 expenditures. The bill prohibits a political committee,
- 19 currently defined in Code, from making an expenditure in this
- 20 state using funds derived from sources outside this state. The
- 21 bill also prohibits a candidate for a political office in this
- 22 state or a candidate's committee from accepting a contribution
- 23 from a person not living in or incorporated or organized under
- 24 the laws of this state, or from any political committee. By
- 25 operation of law, a person who willfully violates a provision
- 26 of the bill is quilty of a serious misdemeanor. A serious
- 27 misdemeanor is punishable by confinement for no more than one
- 28 year and a fine of at least \$430 but not more than \$2,560.
