- 1 Section 1. Section 84A.1B, subsection 14, paragraph a, Code
- 2 2022, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 a. (1) An entry-level hourly wage of not less than fourteen 4 dollars.
- 5 (2) Subparagraph (1) does not apply to jobs at child
- 6 development homes or licensed child care facilities, as those
- 7 terms are defined in section 237A.1, or state or federally
- 8 regulated preschools, for purposes of the future ready Iowa
- 9 skilled workforce last-dollar scholarship program under section
- 10 261.131.
- 11 Sec. 2. Section 256I.11, Code 2022, is amended by adding the
- 12 following new subsection:
- NEW SUBSECTION. 6. For the fiscal year beginning July 1,
- 14 2022, and each subsequent fiscal year, there is appropriated
- 15 from the general fund of the state to the early childhood
- 16 Iowa fund the amount of two hundred sixty-five thousand nine
- 17 hundred fifty dollars. Moneys appropriated pursuant to this
- 18 subsection shall be used by the state board for the purpose of
- 19 assisting in expenses for skills development, tuition expenses,
- 20 endorsements for teaching licenses, and licensure renewal
- 21 for child care providers working in a facility licensed or
- 22 regulated by the state or a federal agency.
- 23 EXPLANATION
- 24 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 25 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 26 This bill relates to financial support for the development
- 27 of early childhood educators.
- 28 The bill exempts jobs at child development homes, licensed
- 29 child care facilities, or state or federally regulated
- 30 preschools from the entry-level hourly wage requirement to
- 31 qualify as a high-demand job for the purposes of the future
- 32 ready Iowa skilled workforce last-dollar scholarship program.
- 33 The program covers the gap between federal and state grants
- 34 and scholarships and tuition and qualified fees for eligible
- 35 students in a program of study that leads to a high-demand job

- 1 as designated by the workforce development board or a community
 2 college.
- 3 The bill provides for a standing appropriation beginning
- 4 FY 2022-2023 from the general fund of the state to the early
- 5 childhood Iowa fund of \$265,950. Moneys appropriated pursuant
- 6 to the bill shall be used by the early childhood Iowa state
- 7 board for the purpose of assisting in expenses for skills
- 8 development, tuition expenses, endorsements for teaching
- 9 licenses, and licensure renewal for child care providers
- 10 working in a facility licensed or regulated by the state or a
- 11 federal agency.
