1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 261E.10A Teacher apprenticeship
2 program.

A teacher apprenticeship program may qualify as a concurrent enrollment course if the program meets the requirements of section 261E.8. For purposes of this section, a *"teacher apprenticeship program"* means a nonsectarian course at or through a community college established under chapter 260C that meets all of the following requirements:

9 1. Is at least two semesters in duration.

Requires a student to observe and participate in teaching
 activities under the direct supervision of a mentor teacher.
 3. Provides the student with college credit that may be
 applied to the credits necessary to obtain a para-educator
 certificate pursuant to section 272.12.

18 This bill establishes a teacher apprenticeship program 19 within the district-to-community college sharing or concurrent 20 enrollment program.

The bill provides that a teacher apprenticeship program may qualify as a concurrent enrollment course under the district-to-community college sharing or concurrent enrollment program if the program meets the requirements related to the concurrent enrollment program established in Code section 26 261E.8. The bill defines "teacher apprenticeship program" as a nonsectarian course at or through a community college that is at least two semesters in duration, requires a student to observe and participate in teaching activities under the direct supervision of a mentor teacher, and provides the student with credit toward a para-educator certificate.

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
