## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the registration requirements for certain
- vessels, requiring water use permits, making appropriations,
- 3 and including effective date provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 462A.5, subsection 3, paragraph a,
- 2 subparagraph (1), Code 2022, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 (1) For vessels of any length without motor or sail, twelve
- 4 twenty dollars.
- 5 Sec. 2. Section 462A.6, subsection 7, paragraph b, Code
- 6 2022, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 b. Conventional design canoes and kayak type vessels.
- 8 thirteen feet or less in of any length.
- 9 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. 462A.6B Water use permit decal —
- 10 water trail development and maintenance fund.
- 11 1. The owner of a conventional design canoe or kayak type
- 12 vessel using the vessel on waters of this state that are under
- 13 the jurisdiction of the commission shall purchase and display
- 14 on the vessel a water use permit decal. The department shall
- 15 make the water use permit decal available to purchase for
- 16 twenty dollars at water recreation facilities operated by the
- 17 department and at retail locations. The water use permit decal
- 18 shall be valid until expiration three years after the date of
- 19 purchase. Moneys from the purchase of water use permit decals
- 20 shall be deposited as provided in subsection 2.
- 21 2. A water trail development and maintenance fund is
- 22 established in the state treasury under the control of the
- 23 department. The fund shall consist of moneys deposited
- 24 in the fund pursuant to subsection 1 and any other moneys
- 25 appropriated to or deposited in the fund. Moneys in the fund
- 26 are appropriated to the department for purposes of developing
- 27 and maintaining water trails in this state, administering
- 28 and enforcing navigation laws, and promoting water safety.
- 29 Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys in the fund that remain
- 30 unencumbered or unobligated at the close of a fiscal year shall
- 31 not revert but shall remain available for expenditure for the
- 32 purposes designated. Notwithstanding section 12C.7, subsection
- 33 2, interest or earnings on moneys in the fund shall be credited
- 34 to the fund.
- 35 Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. The following takes effect July 1,

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1 2023: The sections of this Act amending section 462A.6 and 3 enacting section 462A.6B. 4 EXPLANATION The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 5 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly. This bill relates to registration requirements for certain 8 vessels. Under current law, vessels of any length without a 9 motor shall pay to a county recorder a registration fee of \$12 10 in order for the vessel to be issued an identification number. 11 A vessel may not be used on the waters of this state that are 12 under the jurisdiction of the natural resource commission 13 (NRC) without an identification number. Current law exempts 14 conventional design canoes and kayak type vessels that are 13 15 feet or less in length from the numbering and registration 16 requirements. 17 The bill increases the registration fee for vessels of any 18 length without a motor to \$20. However, the bill exempts a 19 canoe or kayak type vessel of any length from registration 20 requirements. Instead, an owner of a conventional design 21 canoe or kayak type vessel using the vessel on waters of this 22 state under NRC jurisdiction shall purchase and display on the 23 vessel a water use permit decal. The department of natural 24 resources (DNR) shall make the water use permit decal available 25 to purchase for \$20 at water recreation facilities operated by 26 DNR and at retail locations. The water use permit decal shall 27 be valid for three years from the date of purchase. Moneys 28 from the purchase of water use permit decals shall be deposited 29 in the water trail development fund established in the bill. 30 Moneys in the fund are appropriated to DNR for purposes 31 of developing and maintaining water trails in this state,

The provisions of the bill relating to water use permit decals and the water trail development fund take effect July
