- 1 Section 1. Section 216.6A, subsection 2, Code 2022, is
- 2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:
- 3 NEW PARAGRAPH. Ob. It shall be an unfair or discriminatory
- 4 practice for any employer or agent of any employer to inquire
- 5 about a prospective employee's wage or salary history before an
- 6 offer of employment with compensation has been negotiated and
- 7 made to the prospective employee, unless a prospective employee
- 8 has voluntarily disclosed such information.
- 9 Sec. 2. Section 216.6A, Code 2022, is amended by adding the
- 10 following new subsection:
- 11 NEW SUBSECTION. 3A. In an action alleging wage
- 12 discrimination under this section, an employer shall not use an
- 13 employee's prior wage and salary history as a defense to such
- 14 action.
- 15 EXPLANATION
- 16 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 17 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 18 This bill provides that it shall be an unfair or
- 19 discriminatory practice relating to wage discrimination
- 20 under Code chapter 216 for any employer to inquire about a
- 21 prospective employee's wage or salary history before an offer
- 22 of employment with compensation has been made. The bill also
- 23 provides that in an action alleging wage discrimination, an
- 24 employer shall not use an employee's prior wage and salary
- 25 history as a defense.
