## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to tampering with witnesses or jurors, and 2 providing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 720.4, Code 2022, is amended to read as 2 follows:

720.4 Tampering with witnesses or jurors. 3

4 A It shall be unlawful for a person who offers to offer any 5 bribe to any person who the offeror believes has been or may be 6 summoned as a witness or juror in any judicial or arbitration 7 proceeding, or any legislative hearing, or who makes to make 8 any threats toward such person or who forcibly or fraudulently 9 detains detain or restrains restrain such person, with the 10 intent to improperly influence such witness or juror with ll respect to the witness' or juror's testimony or decision in 12 such case, or to prevent such person from testifying or serving 13 in such case, or who, in retaliation for anything lawfully done 14 by any witness or juror in any case, harasses to harass such 15 witness or juror. A person who violates this section commits 16 an aggravated misdemeanor a class "B" felony. 17

## EXPLANATION

The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

20 This bill relates to tampering with witnesses or jurors, and 21 provides penalties.

22 Current law provides that a person who tampers with a witness 23 or juror commits an aggravated misdemeanor. An aggravated 24 misdemeanor is punishable by confinement for no more than two 25 years and a fine of at least \$855 but not more than \$8,540. 26 The bill provides that a person who tampers with a witness 27 or juror commits a class "B" felony. A class "B" felony is 28 punishable by confinement for no more than 25 years.
