- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 694.10, Code 2021, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 7. After a person reported missing has 3 4 been missing for five or more years, up to two immediate family 5 members of the missing person shall be allowed to view the 6 missing person report compiled pursuant to section 694.3 and 7 any updated information relating to the missing person report 8 submitted to the missing person information clearinghouse. 9 The department of public safety may authorize more than two 10 immediate family members of the missing person to view the ll report, provided, however, that an immediate family member 12 who is currently a suspect in an active investigation by 13 law enforcement concerning the missing person shall not be 14 allowed to view the missing person report. Persons viewing 15 the report shall not photograph, share, or otherwise publish 16 the contents of the report. For purposes of this subsection, 17 "immediate family member" means a husband or wife; natural or 18 adoptive parent, child, or sibling; stepparent, stepchild, 19 or stepsibling; father-in-law, mother-in-law, son-in-law, 20 daughter-in-law, brother-in-law, or sister-in-law; or 21 grandparent or grandchild.

This bill relates to the viewing of a missing person report of by immediate family members of a missing person.

The bill provides that after a person reported missing has been missing for five or more years, up to two immediate family members of the missing person shall be allowed to view the missing person report and any updated information relating to the missing person report submitted to the missing person information clearinghouse. The department of public safety may authorize more than two immediate family members of the missing person to view the report, provided, however, that an immediate family member who is currently a suspect in an
