A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to trespass upon vehicles, and making penalties
- 2 applicable.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 716.7, subsection 2, paragraph a, Code
- 2 2021, is amended by adding the following new subparagraph:
- NEW SUBPARAGRAPH. (8) Placing advertising or promotional
- 4 materials, including but not limited to flyers, business cards,
- 5 placards, signs, or pictures that display or offer services
- 6 or goods to be sold or exchanged, or that provide political
- 7 information, upon a vehicle without the consent of the owner,
- 8 lessee, or person in lawful possession of the vehicle.
- 9 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 12 This bill provides that trespass includes the unwanted
- 13 placement of advertising or promotional materials, including
- 14 but not limited to flyers, business cards, placards, signs, or
- 15 pictures that display or offer services or goods to be sold
- 16 or exchanged, or that provide political information, upon a
- 17 vehicle.
- 18 A person who commits trespass commits a simple misdemeanor,
- 19 aggravated misdemeanor, or serious misdemeanor depending on the
- 20 circumstances of the offense.
- 21 For purposes of trespass, a simple misdemeanor is punishable
- 22 by a scheduled fine of \$260 for a first violation, \$645 for
- 23 a second violation, and \$1,285 for a third or subsequent
- 24 violation. A serious misdemeanor is punishable by confinement
- 25 for no more than one year and a fine of at least \$430 but not
- 26 more than \$2,560. An aggravated misdemeanor is punishable by
- 27 confinement for no more than two years and a fine of at least
- 28 \$855 but not more than \$8,540.
