A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to COVID-19 vaccine clinics, making an
2 appropriation, and providing effective and applicability
3 dates.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. COVID-19 VACCINE CLINICS — APPROPRIATION.

2 There is appropriated from the Iowa coronavirus relief fund to
3 the department of public health for the fiscal year beginning
4 July 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2021, the following amount or
5 so much thereof as is necessary for the purpose designated:

6 For distribution to all local boards of health to establish
7 and administer COVID-19 vaccine drive-through clinics:

8 \$ 20,000,000

9 Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys appropriated in this
10 section shall not revert at the close of a fiscal year but
11 shall remain available for the purpose designated.

12 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
13 importance, takes effect upon enactment.

14 Sec. 3. RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY. This Act applies
15 retroactively to July 1, 2020.

16 EXPLANATION

17 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
18 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

19 This bill makes an appropriation from the Iowa coronavirus
20 relief fund to the department of public health for FY 2020-2021
21 for distribution to all local boards of health to establish
22 and administer COVID-19 vaccine drive-through clinics. Moneys
23 appropriated do not revert at the close of the fiscal year, but
24 remain available for the purpose of the bill. The bill takes
25 effect upon enactment and is retroactively applicable to July
26 1, 2020.
