- 1 An Act relating to hands-free operation of electronic
- 2 communication devices while driving, and making penalties
- 3 applicable.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321.276, subsection 1, paragraph b, Code
 2021, is amended by striking the paragraph and inserting in
 3 lieu thereof the following:

b. "Fixed unit global positioning system or navigation system" means an electronic device mounted inside of a motor
vehicle that is capable of providing navigation directions to a
driver based on data entered into the device.

8 Sec. 2. Section 321.276, subsection 1, paragraph c, Code 9 2021, is amended to read as follows:

10 c. "Hand-held electronic communication device" means a mobile 11 telephone or other portable electronic communication device 12 capable of being used to write, send, or view an electronic 13 message. "Hand-held electronic communication device" does not 14 include a voice-operated or hands-free device which allows the 15 user to write, send, or view an electronic message without the 16 use of either hand except to activate or deactivate a feature 17 or function. "Hand-held electronic communication device" does 18 not include a wireless communication device used to transmit or 19 receive data as part of a digital dispatch system. "Hand-held 20 electronic communication device" includes a device which is 21 temporarily mounted inside the motor vehicle, unless the device 22 is a voice-operated or hands-free device.

23 Sec. 3. Section 321.276, subsection 1, Code 2021, is amended 24 by adding the following new paragraph:

25 <u>NEW PARAGRAPH</u>. Od. "Mobile telephone" means the same as 26 defined in 49 C.F.R. §383.5.

27 Sec. 4. Section 321.276, subsection 2, Code 2021, is amended 28 to read as follows:

29 2. A person shall not use a hand-held electronic
30 communication device to write, send, or view an electronic
31 message while driving a motor vehicle unless the motor vehicle
32 is at a complete stop off the traveled portion of the roadway,
33 or unless the hand-held electronic communication device is
34 specifically designed and configured to allow hands-free
35 operation and is used in that manner while driving.

A person does not violate this section by using a fixed 2 unit global positioning system or navigation system or when, 3 for the purpose of engaging in a call, the person selects 4 or enters a telephone number or name in a hand-held mobile 5 telephone or activates, deactivates, or initiates a function of 6 a hand-held mobile telephone to receive navigation directions, 7 provided the person does not manually enter data into the fixed 8 unit global positioning system or navigation system while 9 operating the motor vehicle. The provisions of this subsection relating to writing, 10 b. 11 sending, or viewing an electronic message the use of a 12 hand-held electronic communication device do not apply to the 13 following persons: (1) A member of a public safety agency, as defined in 14 15 section 34.1, performing official duties. 16 (2) A health care professional in the course of an emergency 17 situation. Section 707.6A, subsection 2, paragraph a, 21 unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2021, is amended to read as 22 follows: 23 Driving a motor vehicle in a reckless manner with willful 24 or wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property, 25 in violation of section 321.277. For the purposes of 26 this paragraph, a person's use of a hand-held electronic 27 communication device while driving a motor vehicle in violation 28 of section 321.276 shall be considered prima facie evidence 29 that the person was driving the motor vehicle in a reckless 30 manner with willful or wanton disregard for the safety of 31 persons or property, in violation of section 321.277. 32 Sec. 6. Section 707.6A, subsection 2, paragraph a, 33 subparagraphs (1), (2), and (3), Code 2021, are amended by 34 striking the subparagraphs. Sec. 7. Section 805.8A, subsection 14, paragraph 1, Code 35

1. Writing, sending, or viewing an Use of hand-held

 4 violations. For violations under section 321.276, the scheduled
 5 fine is forty-five dollars.

EXPLANATION

The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

9 This bill prohibits a person from using a hand-held 10 electronic communication device while driving a motor vehicle 11 unless the motor vehicle is at a complete stop off the traveled 12 portion of the roadway, or unless the hand-held electronic 13 communication device is specifically designed and configured 14 to allow hands-free operation and is used in that manner while 15 driving.

16 The bill provides that a person does not violate Code section 17 321.276 by using a fixed unit global positioning system or 18 navigation system to receive navigation directions, provided 19 the person does not manually enter data into the fixed unit 20 global positioning system or navigation system while operating 21 the vehicle.

A violation of Code section 321.276 is punishable by a scheduled fine of \$45. The offense is not a moving violation, and therefore cannot be considered for purposes of administrative suspension of a driver's license or to establish habitual offender status. However, if the violation causes a serious injury, a court could impose an additional fine of \$500 sor suspend the person's driver's license for not more than 90 days, or both. If the violation causes a death, a court could impose an additional fine of \$1,000 or suspend the person's driver's license for not more than 180 days, or both.

The bill aligns provisions in Code section 707.6A (homicide or serious injury by vehicle) relating to the use of a hand-held electronic communication device to the provisions of Code section 321.276 as amended by the bill.
