A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act requiring school districts and accredited nonpublic
- 2 schools to offer and teach in grades nine through twelve
- 3 one unit of the history of refugee migration in and to the
- 4 United States.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 256.11, subsection 5, paragraph b, Code 2 2021, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 b. Five units of the social studies including instruction
- 4 in voting statutes and procedures, voter registration
- 5 requirements, the use of paper ballots and voting systems in
- 6 the election process, and the method of acquiring and casting
- 7 an absentee ballot. One unit of the history of refugee
- 8 migration within and immigration to the United States shall
- 9 also be included. All students shall complete a minimum of
- 10 one-half unit of United States government and one unit of
- 11 United States history. The one-half unit of United States
- 12 government shall include the voting procedure as described in
- 13 this lettered paragraph and section 280.9A. The government
- 14 instruction shall also include a study of the Constitution
- 15 of the United States and the Bill of Rights contained in the
- 16 Constitution and an assessment of a student's knowledge of the
- 17 Constitution and the Bill of Rights.
- 18 Sec. 2. STATE MANDATE FUNDING SPECIFIED. In accordance
- 19 with section 25B.2, subsection 3, the state cost of requiring
- 20 compliance with any state mandate included in this Act shall
- 21 be paid by a school district from state school foundation aid
- 22 received by the school district under section 257.16. This
- 23 specification of the payment of the state cost shall be deemed
- 24 to meet all of the state funding-related requirements of
- 25 section 25B.2, subsection 3, and no additional state funding
- 26 shall be necessary for the full implementation of this Act
- 27 by and enforcement of this Act against all affected school
- 28 districts.
- 29 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 32 This bill requires, within the five units of social studies
- 33 required under Iowa's educational standards, school districts
- 34 and accredited nonpublic schools to offer and teach one unit
- 35 of instruction in the history of refugee migration within

- 1 and immigration to the United States in grades 9 through 12.
- 2 Currently, high school students are required to take three
- 3 years of social studies, including one-half unit of United
- 4 States government and a unit of United States history.
- 5 The bill may include a state mandate as defined in Code
- 6 section 25B.3. The bill requires that the state cost of
- 7 any state mandate included in the bill be paid by a school
- 8 district from state school foundation aid received by the
- 9 school district under Code section 257.16. The specification
- 10 is deemed to constitute state compliance with any state mandate
- 11 funding-related requirements of Code section 25B.2. The
- 12 inclusion of this specification is intended to reinstate the
- 13 requirement of political subdivisions to comply with any state
- 14 mandates included in the bill.
