1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 2.57 Climate impact statements. 2 1. Prior to debate on the floor of a chamber of the general 3 assembly, a climate impact statement shall be attached to any 4 bill, joint resolution, or amendment that proposes a change 5 in the law that can reasonably be interpreted to impact the 6 natural environment including through a change in regulations, 7 cost allocations, or behaviors in the general public. The 8 statement shall include information concerning the impact of 9 the legislation on the state's natural resources, agricultural 10 resources, minority populations, and economic well-being. The 11 statement shall be factual and shall, if possible, provide 12 a reasonable estimate of both the immediate effect and the 13 long-range impact on climate change and environmental health. 14 The legislative services agency shall cause to be 2. 15 prepared a climate impact statement within a reasonable time 16 after receiving a request or determining that a proposal 17 is subject to this section. All climate impact statements 18 approved by the legislative services agency shall be 19 transmitted immediately to either the chief clerk of the house 20 or the secretary of the senate, after notifying the sponsor 21 of the legislation that the statement has been prepared for 22 publication. The chief clerk of the house or the secretary 23 of the senate shall attach the statement to the bill, joint 24 resolution, or amendment affected as soon as it is available. 25 3. The legislative services agency may request the 26 cooperation of any state department or agency or political 27 subdivision in preparing a climate impact statement. A revised climate impact statement shall be prepared 28 4. 29 if the climate impact has been changed by the adoption of an 30 amendment, and may be requested by a member of the general 31 assembly or be prepared upon a determination made by the 32 legislative services agency. However, a request for a revised 33 climate impact statement shall not delay action on the bill, 34 joint resolution, or amendment unless so ordered by the 35 presiding officer of the chamber.

4 This bill provides that the legislative services agency 5 shall prepare a climate impact statement, prior to debate, for 6 any bill, joint resolution, or amendment that proposes a change 7 to the law that can reasonably be interpreted to impact the 8 natural environment, including through a change in regulations, 9 cost allocations, or behaviors in the general public. The 10 bill provides that the statement shall include the impact of 11 legislation on the state's natural resources, agricultural 12 resources, minority populations, and economic well-being. 13 A revised climate impact statement shall be prepared if 14 the climate impact has been changed by the adoption of an 15 amendment, and may be requested by a member of the general 16 assembly or be prepared upon a determination made by the 17 legislative services agency. The bill provides that a request 18 for a revised climate impact statement cannot delay legislative 19 action.
