5 WHEREAS, Representative Landon served in the United
6 States naval construction battalion, the Navy Seabees,
7 during the Vietnam Conflict; and
8 WHEREAS, after receiving an honorable discharge,
9 Representative Landon graduated with a degree in
10 agribusiness from Iowa State University; and

2 nearly 40 years in agricultural real estate and farm
3 management before running for state office; and

4 WHEREAS, Representative Landon faithfully served the
5 people of Iowa as a state representative for over eight
6 years; and

9 leader, and a deacon and a stewardship committee leader
