- This bill relates to conflicts of interest of certain state 4 officials and employees resulting from service on boards of 5 directors of certain organizations.
- The bill prohibits certain elected officials and state employees, during the time in which the person serves as or is employed by the state in such a role, from serving as a member of the board of directors of any entity, whether for profit or nonprofit, that provides goods or services to the state entity which the person serves or which employs the person.
- The persons subject to the prohibition are a person who
 serves as a statewide elected official; the executive or
 administrative head of an agency of state government; the
 deputy executive or administrative head of an agency of state
 government; a member of the general assembly; the head of a
 major subunit of a department or independent state agency
 whose position involves substantial exercise of administrative
 discretion or the expenditure of public funds; a full-time
 employee of an office of a statewide elected official whose
 position involves substantial exercise of administrative
 discretion or the expenditure of public funds; and a state or
 legislative employee whose position involves a substantial
 exercise of administrative discretion or the expenditure of
- A person who knowingly and intentionally violates the provisions of the bill is guilty of a serious misdemeanor and may be reprimanded, suspended, or dismissed from the person's position or otherwise sanctioned. A serious misdemeanor is punishable by confinement for no more than one year and a fine of at least \$430 but not more than \$2,560.
