A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to payments to child care providers from
2 families participating in the state child care assistance
3 program.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 237A.13, Code 2022, is amended by adding
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 4A. A child care provider shall be allowed
4 to collect from a family participating in the state child care
5 assistance program the difference between the state child care
6 assistance reimbursement rate and the rate the provider would
7 typically charge a private-pay family for child care, provided
8 the child care provider and family agree in writing to such
9 additional payments prior to the provision of the child care.

13 This bill relates to payments to child care providers from
14 families participating in the state child care assistance (CCA)
15 program.

16 The bill allows a child care provider to collect from a
17 family participating in the CCA program the difference between
18 the CCA program reimbursement rate and the rate the provider
19 would typically charge a private-pay family for child care,
20 provided the child care provider and family agree in writing to
21 such additional payments prior to the provision of the child
22 care.
