

**House Study Bill 514 - Introduced**

**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to Medicaid waiver monthly budget cap annual  
2 reporting requirements.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. 2019 Iowa Acts, chapter 82, section 1, is amended  
2 to read as follows:

3 SEC. 1. MEDICAID HOME AND COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES BRAIN  
4 INJURY WAIVER MAXIMUM. The department of human services shall  
5 eliminate the monthly budget maximum or cap for individuals  
6 eligible for the Medicaid home and community-based services  
7 brain injury waiver. The department shall track the average  
8 amount expended per waiver recipient each fiscal year beginning  
9 July 1, 2019, and shall report the information annually to the  
10 governor and the general assembly by ~~October 1~~ December 30.

11 Sec. 2. 2020 Iowa Acts, chapter 1053, section 1, is amended  
12 to read as follows:

13 SEC. 1. MEDICAID HOME AND COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES ELDERLY  
14 WAIVER MAXIMUM. The department of human services shall  
15 eliminate the monthly budget maximum or cap for individuals  
16 eligible for the Medicaid home and community-based services  
17 elderly waiver. The department shall track the average amount  
18 expended per waiver recipient each fiscal year beginning July  
19 1, 2020, and shall report the information annually to the  
20 governor and the general assembly by ~~October 1~~ December 30.

EXPLANATION

22 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
23 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

24 This bill changes the date by which the department of human  
25 services is required to submit an annual report to the governor  
26 and the general assembly regarding the average amount expended  
27 per Medicaid waiver recipient for the elderly waiver and the  
28 brain injury waiver each fiscal year from October 1 to December  
29 30.
