A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the Iowa public broadcasting board,
- 2 including the board's authority with respect to intellectual 3 property.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 256.84, subsection 5, Code 2022, is
2 amended to read as follows:

5. The board shall establish guidelines for and may impose 4 and collect fees and charges for services. Fees and charges 5 collected by the board for services shall be deposited to the 6 credit of the division. Any interest earned on these receipts, 7 and revenues generated under subsection 7 <u>6</u>, shall be retained 8 and may be expended by the division subject to the approval of 9 the board.

10 Sec. 2. Section 256.84, Code 2022, is amended by adding the 11 following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 10A. a. The board may own, acquire, secure, apply for, and receive intellectual property rights, including copyrights, trademarks, service marks, patents, and trade secrets, and enforce the rights of the board with respect to such intellectual property rights.

17 b. The board may enter into agreements for the sale, 18 licensing, distribution, or other use of or access to the 19 board's intellectual property rights. The board may charge 20 fees in connection with the rights granted under such 21 agreements.

Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, 22 C. 23 the board may restrict the access to, use of, exploitation 24 of, or dissemination of the board's or the division's works, 25 derivative works, content, records, recordings, videos, audio, 26 footage, photographs, artwork, music, compilations, electronic 27 storage, documents, inventions, marks, trade secrets, tape, and 28 other information or material, if any of the following apply: 29 (1) The works, derivative works, content, records, 30 recordings, videos, audio, footage, photographs, artwork, 31 music, compilations, electronic storage, documents, inventions, 32 marks, trade secrets, tape, or other information or material 33 is protected by law or subject to the board's intellectual 34 property rights.

13 This bill relates to the Iowa public broadcasting board, 14 including the board's authority with respect to intellectual 15 property.

16 The bill authorizes the board to own intellectual property 17 rights and enforce the rights of the board with respect to such 18 intellectual property rights.

The bill authorizes the board to enter into agreements for 19 20 the use of or access to the board's intellectual property The bill provides that the board may charge fees in 21 rights. 22 connection with the rights granted under such agreements. The bill provides that the board may restrict the access 23 24 to or use of the board's or the public broadcasting division 25 of the department of education's works, derivative works, 26 content, records, recordings, videos, audio, footage, 27 photographs, artwork, music, compilations, electronic storage, 28 documents, inventions, marks, trade secrets, tape, and other 29 information or material if the works, derivative works, or 30 other information or material is protected by law or subject 31 to the board's intellectual property rights or if the works, 32 derivative works, or other information or material contain 33 content, records, music, footage, artwork, photographs, 34 video, audio, recordings, footage, works, derivative works, 35 compilations, or other property or material in which the

 or managed by or on behalf of another person or are subject to
 limitations contained in licensing or other agreements.

4 The bill also corrects an internal reference in Code section 5 256.84(5) relating to revenue generated from contracts entered 6 into by the board.
