- 1 An Act relating to licenses issued by the board of educational
- 2 examiners to teachers licensed out of state.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 272.2, subsection 17, Code 2022, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 17. Adopt rules to require that a background investigation
- 4 be conducted by the division of criminal investigation of the
- 5 department of public safety on all initial applicants for
- 6 licensure, and all applicants under subsection 27. The board
- 7 shall also require all initial applicants and all applicants
- 8 under subsection 27 to submit a completed fingerprint packet
- 9 and shall use the packet to facilitate a national criminal
- 10 history background check. The board shall have access to,
- 11 and shall review the sex offender registry information under
- 12 section 692A.121 available to the general public, information
- 13 in the Iowa court information system available to the general
- 14 public, the central registry for child abuse information
- 15 established under chapter 235A, and the dependent adult abuse
- 16 records maintained under chapter 235B for information regarding
- 17 applicants for license renewal.
- 18 Sec. 2. Section 272.2, Code 2022, is amended by adding the
- 19 following new subsection:
- 20 NEW SUBSECTION. 27. Adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A
- 21 requiring the board to issue a teaching license with the
- 22 applicable endorsements to an applicant who is licensed as a
- 23 teacher in another state, whose license is in good standing,
- 24 and who has been working as a teacher in that state for the past
- 25 three consecutive years, that allows the applicant to teach
- 26 the same grade levels and subjects the applicant is licensed
- 27 to teach in the other state. This subsection does not require
- 28 that a school district or an accredited nonpublic school has
- 29 offered a teaching contract to the applicant.
- 30 EXPLANATION
- 31 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 32 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 33 This bill relates to licenses issued by the board of
- 34 educational examiners (BOEE) to teachers licensed out of state.
- 35 The bill requires the BOEE to issue a teaching license with

- 1 the applicable endorsements to an applicant who is licensed as
- 2 a teacher in another state, whose license is in good standing,
- 3 and who has been working as a teacher in that state for the past
- 4 three consecutive years, that allows the applicant to teach the
- 5 same grade levels and subjects the applicant is licensed to
- 6 teach in the other state. The bill provides that the applicant
- 7 is not required to have been offered a teaching contract by a
- 8 school district or an accredited nonpublic school.
- 9 The bill establishes that applicants for these licenses
- 10 are subject to the requirements related to background
- 11 investigations, the submission of fingerprint packets, and
- 12 criminal history searches applicable to all initial applicants
- 13 for licensure.
