A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to area education agencies, including
- 2 consolidating the area education agencies, modifying the
- 3 teacher salary supplement state cost per pupil calculation,
- 4 and modifying the employment terms of certain specified
- 5 employees of area education agencies.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 257.9, subsection 6, Code 2022, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 6. Teacher salary supplement state cost per pupil. For the
- 4 budget year beginning July 1, 2009, for the teacher salary
- 5 supplement state cost per pupil, the department of management
- 6 shall add together the teacher compensation allocation made
- 7 to each district for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2008,
- 8 pursuant to section 284.13, subsection 1, paragraph "h", Code
- 9 2009, and the phase II allocation made to each district for
- 10 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2008, pursuant to section
- 11 294A.9, Code 2009, and divide that sum by the statewide total
- 12 budget enrollment for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009.
- 13 The teacher salary supplement state cost per pupil for the
- 14 budget year beginning July 1, 2010, and succeeding budget years
- 15 beginning before July 1, 2023, shall be the amount calculated
- 16 by the department of management under this subsection for the
- 17 base year plus a supplemental state aid amount that is equal
- 18 to the teacher salary supplement categorical state percent of
- 19 growth, pursuant to section 257.8, subsection 2, for the budget
- 20 year, multiplied by the amount calculated by the department
- 21 of management under this subsection for the base year. The
- 22 teacher salary supplement state cost per pupil for the budget
- 23 year beginning July 1, 2023, shall be the amount calculated
- 24 by the department of management under this subsection for the
- 25 base year plus a supplemental state aid amount that is equal
- 26 to the teacher salary supplement categorical state percent of
- 27 growth, pursuant to section 257.8, subsection 2, for the budget
- 28 year, multiplied by the amount calculated by the department
- 29 of management under this subsection for the base year, plus
- 30 the quotient of the difference between the sum of the total
- 31 approved budgets for all area education agencies excluding
- 32 federal moneys for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and
- 33 the sum of the total approved budgets for all area education

- 1 for the budget year. The teacher salary supplement state
- 2 cost per pupil for the budget year beginning July 1, 2024,
- 3 and succeeding budget years, shall be the amount calculated
- 4 by the department of management under this subsection for the
- 5 base year plus a supplemental state aid amount that is equal
- 6 to the teacher salary supplement categorical state percent of
- 7 growth, pursuant to section 257.8, subsection 2, for the budget
- 8 year, multiplied by the amount calculated by the department of
- 9 management under this subsection for the base year.
- 10 Sec. 2. Section 257.10, subsection 9, paragraph a, Code
- 11 2022, is amended to read as follows:
- 12 a. For the budget year beginning July 1, 2009, the
- 13 department of management shall add together the teacher
- 14 compensation allocation made to each district for the fiscal
- 15 year beginning July 1, 2008, pursuant to section 284.13,
- 16 subsection 1, paragraph "h", Code 2009, and the phase II
- 17 allocation made to each district for the fiscal year beginning
- 18 July 1, 2008, pursuant to section 294A.9, Code 2009, and divide
- 19 that sum by the district's budget enrollment in the fiscal
- 20 year beginning July 1, 2009, to determine the teacher salary
- 21 supplement district cost per pupil. For the budget year
- 22 beginning July 1, 2010, and succeeding budget years beginning
- 23 before July 1, 2023, the teacher salary supplement district
- 24 cost per pupil for each school district for a budget year
- 25 is the teacher salary supplement program district cost per
- 26 pupil for the base year plus the teacher salary supplement
- 27 supplemental state aid amount for the budget year. For
- 28 the budget year beginning July 1, 2023, the teacher salary
- 29 supplement district cost per pupil for each school district
- 30 for a budget year is the teacher salary supplement program
- 31 district cost per pupil for the base year plus the teacher
- 32 salary supplement supplemental state aid amount for the budget
- 33 year plus the quotient of the difference between the sum of
- 34 the total approved budgets for all area education agencies
- 35 excluding federal moneys for the fiscal year beginning July 1,

- 1 2022, and the sum of the total approved budgets for all area
- 2 education agencies excluding federal moneys for the fiscal year
- 3 beginning July 1, 2023, divided by the statewide total budget
- 4 enrollment for the budget year. For the budget year beginning
- 5 July 1, 2024, and succeeding budget years, the teacher salary
- 6 supplement district cost per pupil for each school district for
- 7 a budget year is the teacher salary supplement program district
- 8 cost per pupil for the base year plus the teacher salary
- 9 supplement supplemental state aid amount for the budget year.
- Sec. 3. Section 273.3, Code 2022, is amended by adding the
- 11 following new subsection:
- 12 NEW SUBSECTION. 26. Allow any person employed by the area
- 13 education agency who holds a license, certificate, statement
- 14 of recognition, or authorization other than a coaching
- 15 authorization, issued by the board of educational examiners
- 16 under chapter 272, to do all of the following:
- 17 a. Live outside the boundaries of the area education agency.
- 18 b. Provide educational services and programs that meet the
- 19 requirements established by rule pursuant to section 256.7,
- 20 subsection 32, paragraph c, to students primarily over the
- 21 internet, but only when such services and programs can be
- 22 provided effectively over the internet.
- 23 Sec. 4. NEW SECTION. 273.21A Consolidation of area
- 24 education agencies.
- On and after July 1, 2023, the number of area education
- 26 agencies shall not exceed four. Area education agencies shall
- 27 reorganize as necessary to implement this requirement. Area
- 28 education agencies engaging in such reorganization shall be
- 29 contiguous. Sections 273.22 and 273.23 shall apply to such
- 30 reorganizations.
- 31 Sec. 5. Section 273.23, subsection 1, Code 2022, is amended
- 32 to read as follows:
- 33 1. A petition filed under section 273.21 or a reorganization
- 34 plan submitted in compliance with section 273.21A shall state
- 35 the number of directors on the initial board which shall be

- 1 either seven or nine directors. The petition or plan shall
- 2 specify the number of directors to be retained from each area,
- 3 and those numbers shall be proportionate to the populations
- 4 of the agencies. If the proportionate balance of directors
- 5 among the affected agencies specified in the petition or plan
- 6 is affected by school districts petitioning to be excluded
- 7 from the reorganization, or if the proposal specified in the
- 8 plan does not comply with the requirement for proportionate
- 9 representation, the state board shall modify the proposal.
- 10 However, all area education agencies affected shall retain at
- 11 least one member.
- 12 Sec. 6. IMPLEMENTATION. Area education agencies engaging
- 13 in initial reorganization pursuant to section 273.21A, as
- 14 enacted by this Act, shall complete the procedures described
- 15 in section 273.21, subsection 3, paragraphs "a" through "q".
- 16 However, reorganization plans shall be submitted to the state
- 17 board of education no later than January 1, 2023. The state
- 18 board shall review a reorganization plan and shall, prior to
- 19 March 15, 2023, either approve the plan as submitted, approve
- 20 the plan contingent upon compliance with the state board's
- 21 recommendations, or disapprove the plan. A contingently
- 22 approved plan shall be resubmitted with modifications to
- 23 the department of education not later than May 1, 2023. If
- 24 one or more area education agencies do not timely submit a
- 25 reorganization plan, the department shall, in consultation with
- 26 such agencies, prepare and approve a reorganization plan for
- 27 such agencies. An approved plan shall take effect on July 1,
- 28 2023.
- 29 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 32 This bill relates to area education agencies, including
- 33 consolidating the area education agencies, modifying the
- 34 teacher salary supplement state cost per pupil calculation, and
- 35 modifying the employment terms of certain specified employees

1 of area education agencies.

- 2 Current law establishes a maximum of 15 area education
- 3 agencies throughout the state. There are currently nine area
- 4 education agencies in the state. Area education agencies
- 5 provide means of identifying and serving children who require
- 6 special education and provide for media services and other
- 7 programs for pupils in grades kindergarten through 12 and
- 8 children requiring special education. The bill provides
- 9 that the number of area education agencies shall not exceed
- 10 four on and after July 1, 2023. The bill requires area
- 11 education agencies to reorganize as necessary to implement
- 12 this requirement and specifies that area education agencies
- 13 engaging in such reorganization shall be contiguous. The bill
- 14 provides that Code sections 273.22 and 273.23, relating to the
- 15 terms of employment of area education agency employees and the
- 16 organization of initial area education agency boards, apply to
- 17 such reorganizations. The bill provides a timeline for the
- 18 implementation of reorganization of area education agencies by
- 19 July 1, 2023.
- 20 Under current law, the teacher salary supplement state cost
- 21 per pupil is the teacher salary supplement state cost per
- 22 pupil for the base year plus a supplemental state aid amount
- 23 that is equal to the categorical state percent of growth for
- 24 the budget year, multiplied by the teacher salary supplement
- 25 state cost per pupil for the base year. The bill modifies the
- 26 calculation of the teacher salary supplement state cost per
- 27 pupil for the budget year beginning July 1, 2023, by adding to
- 28 the existing amount the difference between the sum of the total
- 29 approved budgets for all area education agencies excluding
- 30 federal moneys for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and
- 31 such budget amount for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023,
- 32 divided by the statewide total budget enrollment for the budget 33 year.
- 34 The bill then, for budget years beginning on or after
- 35 July 1, 2024, resumes the calculation of the teacher salary

- 1 supplement state cost per pupil in the manner the amount was
- 2 calculated previously. The bill also adjusts the calculation
- 3 of the teacher salary supplement district cost per pupil in a
- 4 similar manner for the budget year beginning July 1, 2023, and
- 5 subsequent budget years.
- 6 The bill requires the boards of directors of area
- 7 education agencies to allow any person employed by the area
- 8 education agency who holds a license, certificate, statement
- 9 of recognition, or authorization other than a coaching
- 10 authorization, issued by the board of educational examiners
- 11 under Code chapter 272, to live outside the boundaries of the
- 12 area education agency and provide educational services and
- 13 programs meeting certain specified requirements to students
- 14 primarily over the internet, but only when such services and
- 15 programs can be provided effectively over the internet.
