SENATE FILE 157

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A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to community action agencies, making an
2 appropriation, and including effective and applicability
3 date provisions.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RIGHTS — COMMUNITY ACTION
2 AGENCIES — SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated
3 from the general fund of the state to the division of community
4 action agencies of the department of human rights for the
5 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, and ending June 30,
6 2021, in addition to any other funding appropriated for such
7 purposes for the same fiscal year, the following amount, or
8 so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purposes
9 designated:

10 To support the duties of the community action agencies
11 pursuant to section 216A.96, including providing food
12 assistance, food distribution, and food delivery:

13 \$ 5,000,000

14 Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys appropriated under this
15 section shall not revert at the close of the fiscal year, but
16 shall remain available for the purposes designated.

17 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
18 importance, takes effect upon enactment.

19 Sec. 3. APPLICABILITY. This Act applies retroactively to
20 July 1, 2020.

21 EXPLANATION

22 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
23 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

24 This bill makes a supplemental appropriation to the division
25 of community action agencies of the department of human rights
26 for fiscal year 2020-2021, in addition to any other funding
27 appropriated for such purposes for the same fiscal year, to
28 support the duties of the community action agencies including
29 providing food assistance, food distribution, and food
30 delivery. The moneys appropriated do no revert to the general
31 fund at the close of the fiscal year, but remain available for
32 the purposes designated. The bill takes effect upon enactment
33 and is retroactively applicable to July 1, 2020.
