A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the protection and improvement of public
2 health, and making an appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH — LOCAL BOARDS
2 OF HEALTH — APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated from the
3 general fund of the state to the department of public health
4 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June
5 30, 2022, in addition to any other funding appropriated or
6 otherwise provided for such purposes for the same fiscal year,
7 the following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be
8 used for the purposes designated:

9 For distribution to local boards of health for duties
10 related to the protection and improvement of public health
11 including the support of COVID-19 related activities:
12 \$ 10,000,000

13 Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys appropriated under this
14 section shall not revert at the close of the fiscal year, but
15 shall remain available for the purposes designated.

16 EXPLANATION

17 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
18 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

19 This bill makes an appropriation from the general fund of
20 the state to the department of public health for fiscal year
21 2021-2022, in addition to any other funding appropriated or
22 otherwise provided for such purposes for the same fiscal year,
23 for distribution to local boards of health for the protection
24 and improvement of public health including the support of
25 COVID-19 related activities. Moneys appropriated under the
26 bill do not revert at the close of the fiscal year but remain
27 available for the purpose designated.
