- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 135B.36 Maternal health best 2 practices or safety bundles.
- 3 A hospital licensed under this chapter that provides labor
- 4 and delivery services shall adopt and implement the current
- 5 best practices or safety bundles recommended by the American
- 6 college of obstetricians and gynecologists and the alliance
- 7 for innovation on maternal health including but not limited to
- 8 action measures for obstetrical hemorrhage, severe hypertension
- 9 or preeclampsia, prevention of venous thromboembolism,
- 10 reduction of low-risk primary cesarean births and support
- 11 for intended vaginal births, reduction of peripartum racial
- 12 disparities, and postpartum care access and standards.
