A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to terms used in the context of land surveying.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 355.5, subsection 4, Code 2022, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 4. Distances shall be shown in decimal feet in accordance
- 4 with the federal definition of the U.S. survey a foot at the
- 5 time the survey is performed. Distance measurements shall
- 6 refer to the horizontal plane.
- 7 Sec. 2. Section 355.16, Code 2022, is amended to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 355.16 Iowa plane coordinate system defined.
- The Iowa plane coordinate system shall be used for the
- ll purpose of conducting official surveys. As used in this
- 12 subchapter, unless the context otherwise requires section, "Iowa
- 13 plane coordinate system" or "coordinate system" means the system
- 14 of plane coordinates established by the United States national
- 15 ocean survey, or the United States national geodetic survey,
- 16 or a successor agency, for defining and stating the geographic
- 17 positions or locations of points on the surface of the earth
- 18 within the state of Iowa that is in use at the time the survey
- 19 is performed.
- 20 Sec. 3. REPEAL. Sections 355.17, 355.18, and 355.19, Code
- 21 2022, are repealed.
- 22 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 24 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 25 This bill relates to terms used in the context of land
- 26 surveying. The bill requires distances for a survey to be
- 27 shown in decimal feet in accordance with the federal definition
- 28 of a foot at the time the survey is performed rather than the
- 29 definition of the U.S. survey foot. The bill strikes the
- 30 requirement that distance measurements refer to the horizontal
- 31 plane. The bill provides that the Iowa plane coordinate system
- 32 shall be used for the purpose of conducting official surveys.
- 33 The bill amends the definition of "Iowa plane coordinate
- 34 system" to mean the system established solely by the United
- 35 States geodetic survey, or a successor agency, in use at the

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- 1 time the survey is performed. The bill repeals provisions
- 2 relating to the designation of coordinate zones, identification
- 3 of geographic locations, and application of terms associated
- 4 with the Iowa plane coordinate system as it exists under
- 5 current law.
