A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act concerning compensation and benefits limits, relating to
- 2 the earnings limitation for retirees under the Iowa public
- 3 employees' retirement system and compensation limits for
- 4 school corporation board members, and including effective
- 5 date provisions.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

S.F. 2266

- 1 Section 1. Section 97B.48A, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code 2 2022, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 a. If a member who has not reached the member's sixty-fifth
- 4 birthday and who has a bona fide retirement under this chapter
- 5 is in regular full-time employment during a calendar year,
- 6 the member's retirement allowance shall be reduced by fifty
- 7 cents for each dollar the member earns over the limit provided
- 8 in this subsection. However, employment is not full-time
- 9 employment until the member receives remuneration in an amount
- 10 in excess of thirty fifty thousand dollars for a calendar year,
- 11 or an amount equal to the amount of remuneration permitted
- 12 for a calendar year for persons under sixty-five years of
- 13 age before a reduction in federal social security retirement
- 14 benefits is required, whichever is higher. Effective the first
- 15 of the month in which a member attains the age of sixty-five
- 16 years, a retired member may receive a retirement allowance
- 17 without a reduction after return to covered employment
- 18 regardless of the amount of remuneration received.
- 19 Sec. 2. Section 279.7A, subsection 2, Code 2022, is amended
- 20 to read as follows:
- 21 2. This section does not apply to contracts for the
- 22 purchase of goods or services which benefit a director, or
- 23 to compensation for part-time or temporary employment which
- 24 benefits a director, if the benefit to the director does not
- 25 exceed six twenty thousand dollars in a fiscal year, and
- 26 contracts made by a school board, upon competitive bid in
- 27 writing, publicly invited and opened.
- 28 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
- 29 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 30 EXPLANATION
- 31 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 32 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 33 This bill modifies the earnings limitation for retirees
- 34 under the Iowa public employees' retirement system (IPERS) and
- 35 the limitation on compensation and benefits for a member of a

- 1 school board.
- 2 Code section 97B.48A provides that a retiree under IPERS who
- 3 has not reached age 65 shall have their retirement allowance
- 4 reduced by 50 cents for every dollar the retiree earns over
- 5 \$30,000 in full-time employment covered by IPERS. The bill
- 6 raises this earnings limitation provision to \$50,000.
- 7 Code section 279.7A, concerning limitations on contracts
- 8 that benefit a member of the board of directors of a school
- 9 corporation, is amended to allow a contract if the benefit from
- 10 the contract to the director does not exceed \$20,000 instead
- 11 of \$6,000.
- 12 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
