

Senate Study Bill 1163 - Introduced

A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the delivery of alcoholic beverages by
2 retailers.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 123.46A, subsection 2, paragraph g, Code
2 2021, is amended to read as follows:

3 g. Delivery of alcoholic liquor, wine, or beer shall be made
4 by the licensee or permittee, ~~or the licensee's or permittee's~~
5 ~~employee, and not by a third party or the licensee's or~~
6 permittee's agent.

7 Sec. 2. Section 123.46A, subsection 2, paragraph i, Code
8 2021, is amended by striking the paragraph.

9 EXPLANATION

10 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
11 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

12 This bill authorizes the delivery of alcoholic liquor,
13 wine, or beer by the agent of a licensee or permittee, if
14 the licensee or permittee is authorized by the alcoholic
15 beverages division to make such deliveries. Under current law,
16 third parties cannot make such deliveries for a licensee or
17 permittee.

18 The bill strikes a requirement that deliveries of alcoholic
19 liquor, wine, or beer be made in a vehicle owned, leased, or
20 under the control of the licensee or permittee.
