

**Senate Study Bill 3028 - Introduced**

**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to the records of the Iowa public broadcasting  
2 board.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 256.84, Code 2022, is amended by adding  
2 the following new subsections:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 12. All of the board's records, videos,  
4 electronic storage, documents, tape, and other information,  
5 stored or preserved in any medium, are public records pursuant  
6 to chapter 22 and are subject to the rights of examination,  
7 copying, and dissemination as provided in section 22.2, unless  
8 the record, video, electronic storage, document, tape, or other  
9 information is confidential under section 22.7.

10 NEW SUBSECTION. 13. The board, administrator, department,  
11 or any other person on behalf of the state shall not enforce  
12 any copyright, trademark, or any other intellectual property  
13 right associated with a public record identified in subsection  
14 12 more than ten years after the public record was originally  
15 created, produced, filmed, or developed.

16 EXPLANATION

17 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
18 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

19 This bill relates to the records of the Iowa public  
20 broadcasting board.

21 The bill provides that all of the Iowa public broadcasting  
22 board's records, videos, electronic storage, documents, tape,  
23 and other information are public records pursuant to Code  
24 chapter 22 and are subject to the right of examination unless  
25 the record, video, electronic storage, document, tape, or other  
26 information is confidential under Code section 22.7.

27 The bill prohibits the board, the administrator of the  
28 public broadcasting division of the department of education,  
29 the department, and any other person on behalf of the state  
30 from enforcing any intellectual property right associated with  
31 the board's public records more than 10 years after the public  
32 record was originally created.
