

**Senate Study Bill 3092 - Introduced**

**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to the prohibition of specific public fund  
2 expenditures and the certification of human trafficking  
3 prevention training of certain lodging providers, and  
4 including effective date provisions.  
5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 80.45A, subsection 5, paragraph d, Code  
2 2022, is amended to read as follows:

3 d. This section subsection applies to all public funds  
4 expended for a purpose described in paragraph "c" on or after  
5 ~~January 1~~ June 30, 2022.

6 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate  
7 importance, takes effect upon enactment.

8 EXPLANATION

9 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
10 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

11 Under current law, on or after January 1, 2022, public  
12 funds shall not be expended by a public employer or public  
13 employee to procure lodging, procure space or services for  
14 certain activities, or to host certain activities with a  
15 lodging provider that has not certified to the commissioner of  
16 public safety that each of the lodging provider's employees  
17 has completed human trafficking prevention training. The bill  
18 provides that public funds shall not be expended by a public  
19 employer or public employee for such purposes on or after June  
20 30, 2022.

21 The bill is effective upon enactment.
