A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the administration of medical cannabidiol by
2 educational institutions and long-term care facilities.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 124E.11, subsection 2, Code 2022, is
2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:

3 NEW PARAGRAPH. *j.* (1) Adopt rules for the issuance of
4 a medical cannabidiol registration card to an educational
5 institution or long-term care facility allowing employees of
6 the institution or facility to administer medical cannabidiol
7 to patients attending the educational institution or in the
8 care of the long-term care facility.

9 (2) For the purposes of this paragraph, "*educational*
10 *institution*" means a public or private elementary school,
11 secondary school, technical or vocational school, community
12 college, college, or university, and "*long-term care facility*"
13 means a health care facility as defined in section 135C.1, an
14 elder group home as defined in section 231B.1, or an assisted
15 living program as defined in section 231C.2.

16 EXPLANATION

17 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
18 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

19 This bill relates to the administration of medical
20 cannabidiol by employees of educational institutions and
21 long-term care facilities, both defined in the bill. The bill
22 requires the department of public health to adopt rules for
23 the issuance of a medical cannabidiol registration card to an
24 educational institution or long-term care facility to allow
25 the employees of such an institution or facility to administer
26 medical cannabidiol to patients attending the institution or in
27 the care of the facility.
