## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to emergency food assistance and making
- 2 appropriations.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## H.F. 167

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **217.41D** Emergency food assistance 2 appropriation.
- For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and for
   each fiscal year thereafter through the fiscal year beginning
- 5 July 1, 2027, there is appropriated from the general fund
- 6 of the state to the department of health and human services
- 7 one million dollars for the support of an Iowa food bank
- 8 association selected by the department of health and human
- 9 services for the purchase of food on behalf of an Iowa
- 10 emergency feeding organization or for the distribution of
- 11 moneys to the Iowa emergency feeding organizations for the
- 12 purchase of food.
- 2. The moneys appropriated in this section shall be
- 14 allocated only to the extent that such moneys are matched on a
- 15 dollar-for-dollar basis.
- 3. Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys appropriated in
- 17 this section that remain unencumbered or unobligated at the
- 18 close of the fiscal year shall not revert but shall remain
- 19 available for expenditure for the purposes designated until the
- 20 close of the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2027.
- 21 4. This section is repealed July 1, 2028.
- 22 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 25 This bill creates a standing appropriation of \$1 million
- 26 from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year
- 27 beginning July 1, 2023, through the fiscal year beginning July
- 28 1, 2027, to the department of health and human services for
- 29 support of an Iowa food bank association to buy food on behalf
- 30 of an Iowa emergency feeding organization or distribute the
- 31 moneys to such organizations for the purchase of food.
- 32 The moneys appropriated shall only be allocated if it is
- 33 matched dollar-for-dollar. Any moneys unused during a fiscal
- 34 year shall remain available for the same purpose until the end
- 35 of the following fiscal year.
