**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to the salary of county attorneys in certain  
2 counties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 331.752, subsection 5, Code 2024, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 5. The resolution changing the status of a county attorney  
4 shall state the initial annual salary to be paid to the county  
5 attorney when the full-time or part-time status is effective.  
6 The annual salary specified in the resolution shall remain  
7 effective until changed as provided in [section 331.907](#). ~~Except~~  
8 ~~in counties having a population of more than two hundred~~  
9 ~~thousand, the annual salary of a full-time county attorney~~  
10 ~~shall be an amount which is between forty-five percent and one~~  
11 ~~hundred percent of the annual salary received by a district~~  
12 ~~court judge.~~

13 EXPLANATION

14 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
15 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

16 This bill relates to the salary of county attorneys  
17 in certain counties. Current law requires counties with  
18 populations of more than 200,000 to pay county attorneys a  
19 salary between 45 and 100 percent of a district court judge's  
20 salary. The bill strikes this requirement.
