## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the double up food bucks program and making
- 2 an appropriation.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## H.F. 2022

- 1 Section 1. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES DOUBLE
- 2 UP FOOD BUCKS PROGRAM SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION. There
- 3 is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the
- 4 department of health and human services for the fiscal year
- 5 beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025, in addition
- 6 to any other funding appropriated for such purpose, the
- 7 following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be
- 8 used for the purposes designated:
- 9 To provide grants to support the double up food bucks
- 10 program administered by the Iowa healthiest state initiative
- 11 to make fresh fruits and vegetables sold at farmers markets,
- 12 grocery stores, and other participating locations accessible
- 13 to individuals and families who reside in this state and
- 14 receive assistance through the federal supplemental nutrition
- 15 assistance program:
- 16 ..... \$ 1,000,000
- 17 1. Beginning January 1, 2025, the department of health
- 18 and human services, in cooperation with the Iowa healthiest
- 19 state initiative, shall submit an annual report to the general
- 20 assembly that provides all of the following information related
- 21 to the double up food bucks program, including but not limited
- 22 to:
- 23 a. The utilization rate of all individuals eligible to
- 24 participate in the program.
- 25 b. The participating locations providing access to
- 26 participants in the program.
- 27 c. Participant demographics.
- 28 2. Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys appropriated under
- 29 this section shall not revert at the close of the fiscal year,
- 30 but shall remain available for the purposes designated.
- 31 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 34 This bill relates to the double up food bucks program by
- 35 making a supplemental appropriation from the general fund

- 2 (HHS) for fiscal year 2024-2025, in addition to any other
- 3 funding appropriated for such purpose for the same fiscal
- 4 year, to provide grants to support the double up food bucks
- 5 program administered by the Iowa healthiest state initiative
- 6 to make fresh fruits and vegetables sold at farmers markets,
- 7 grocery stores, and other participating locations accessible
- 8 to individuals and families who reside in this state and
- 9 receive assistance through the federal supplemental nutrition
- 10 assistance program.
- 11 Beginning January 1, 2025, HHS, in cooperation with the Iowa
- 12 healthiest state initiative, shall submit an annual report
- 13 to the general assembly that provides information related to
- 14 the double up food bucks program, including but not limited
- 15 to the utilization rate of participants in the program, the
- 16 participating locations providing access to participants,
- 17 and participant demographics. Moneys appropriated under the
- 18 bill do not revert at the close of the fiscal year but remain
- 19 available for the purposes of the double up food bucks program.
