A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the dissemination and exhibition of obscene
- 2 material to minors, and providing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 728.2, Code 2024, is amended to read as 2 follows:
- 728.2 Dissemination and exhibition of obscene material to 4 minors.
- 5 Any person, other than the parent or guardian of the minor,
- 6 who knowingly disseminates or exhibits obscene material to a
- 7 minor, including the exhibition of obscene material so that
- 8 it can be observed by a minor on or off the premises where it
- 9 is displayed, is guilty of a public offense and shall upon
- 10 conviction be guilty of a serious an aggravated misdemeanor.
- 11 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 14 This bill relates to the dissemination and exhibition of 15 obscene material to minors.
- 16 Current law provides that any person, other than the parent
- 17 or guardian of the minor, who knowingly disseminates or
- 18 exhibits obscene material, including the exhibition of obscene
- 19 material so that it can be observed by a minor on or off the
- 20 premises where it is displayed, commits a serious misdemeanor.
- 21 The bill increases the penalty to an aggravated misdemeanor.
- 22 A serious misdemeanor is punishable by confinement for no
- 23 more than one year and a fine of at least \$430 but not more than
- 24 \$2,560. An aggravated misdemeanor is punishable by confinement
- 25 for no more than two years and a fine of at least \$855 but not
- 26 more than \$8,540.
- 27 A violation of Code section 728.2 is a tier I sex offense and
- 28 a person convicted of the offense is required to register as a
- 29 sex offender for a period of 10 years.
