- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 232.75, subsection 3, Code 2024, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3. A person who reports or causes to be reported to the
- 4 department false information regarding an alleged act of child
- 5 abuse, knowing that the information is false or that the act
- 6 did not occur, commits a simple misdemeanor class "D" felony.
- 7 Sec. 2. Section 232.75, Code 2024, is amended by adding the
- 8 following new subsection:
- 9 NEW SUBSECTION. 4. If a person who commits a violation of
- 10 subsection 3 is a person responsible for the care of a child,
- 11 as defined in section 232.68, subsection 8, the department
- 12 shall conduct a family assessment, as defined in section
- 13 232.68, subsection 5, paragraph c, concerning any child in
- 14 the care of the person who knowingly made the false report of
- 15 alleged child abuse.
- 16 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 19 This bill relates to reports of false information regarding
- 20 an alleged act of child abuse and family assessments.
- 21 Under current law, a person who reports or causes to be
- 22 reported to the department of health and human services
- 23 (department) false information regarding an alleged act of
- 24 child abuse, knowing that the information is false or that the
- 25 act did not occur, commits a simple misdemeanor.
- 26 The bill increases the current penalty for knowingly making
- 27 a false report of alleged child abuse from a simple misdemeanor
- 28 to a class "D" felony. A simple misdemeanor is punishable by
- 29 confinement for no more than 30 days and a fine of at least \$105
- 30 but not more than \$855. A class "D" felony is punishable by
- 31 confinement for no more than five years and a fine of at least
- 32 \$1,025 but not more than \$10,245.
- The bill provides that if a person convicted of reporting or
- 34 causing the report of false information regarding an alleged
- 35 act of child abuse, knowing that the information is false, is

- 1 a person responsible for the care of a child, as defined in
- 2 Code section 232.68(8), the department shall conduct a family
- 3 assessment, as defined in Code section 232.68(5)(c) concerning
- 4 any child in the care of the person who knowingly made a false
- 5 report of alleged child abuse.
