A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to obscene material available on devices
- 2 and imposing civil liability on entities who publish or
- 3 distribute obscene material on the internet.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 554H.1 Publication and distribution
 2 of obscene material to minors on the internet.

3 1. For purposes of this chapter:

4 *a.* "*Interactive computer service*" means the same as that 5 term is defined in 47 U.S.C. §230.

b. "Obscene material" means the same as defined in section
7 728.1, subsection 5.

8 2. "Social media platform" means an internet search engine, 9 internet website, internet system, access software provider, 10 or application that is open to the public, allows a user 11 of the platform to create an account, and enables users to 12 communicate with one another for the primary purpose of posting 13 information, comments, messages, or images. "Social media 14 platform" does not include any of the following:

15 *a.* An internet service provider.

16 b. Electronic mail.

17 c. An online service, application, or website that consists 18 primarily of news, sports, entertainment, or other information 19 or content that is not user generated but is preselected by 20 the provider and for which any chat, comments, or interactive 21 functionality is incidental to, directly related to, or 22 dependent on the content.

3. Any commercial entity or social media platform that knowingly or intentionally publishes or distributes obscene material to minors on the internet from a website that contains such material shall verify that any person attempting to access obscene material is not a minor through the use of any of the following:

a. A commercially available database that is regularly used
 30 by businesses or governmental entities for the purpose of age
 31 and identity verification

32 *b.* Another commercially reasonable method of age and 33 identity verification.

34 4. Any commercial entity or social media platform that35 violates the provisions of this section shall be subject to

1 civil liability for damages resulting from a minor's access to 2 obscene material and reasonable attorney fees and costs. 3 5. This section shall not be construed to impose civil 4 liability on a provider or user of an interactive computer 5 service on the internet.

EXPLANATION

The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

9 This bill creates civil liability for commercial entities 10 and social media platforms who publish or distribute material ll harmful to minors on the internet. The bill provides any 12 commercial entity or social media platform that knowingly 13 or intentionally publishes or distributes obscene material 14 to minors on the internet from a website that contains such 15 material shall be held civilly liable if the entity fails to 16 perform reasonable age verification methods to verify the 17 age of individuals attempting to access the material. Any 18 commercial entity or social media platform that is found in 19 violation shall be civilly liable to an individual for damages 20 resulting from a minor's accessing the material, including 21 court costs and reasonable attorney fees as ordered by the 22 court. The bill does not impose civil liability on a provider 23 or user of an interactive computer service on the internet.
