A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to disclosure of the electronic protected
- 2 health information of a minor to a legal guardian.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 135.194 Electronic protected health
- 2 information of minor disclosure to legal guardian.
- 3 1. A health care provider or facility that maintains
- 4 or transmits electronic protected health information shall
- 5 disclose to the legal guardian of a minor the minor's
- 6 electronic protected health information, with the following
- 7 exceptions:
- 8 a. Electronic protected health information that relates
- 9 to health care for which the minor is legally authorized to
- 10 consent without the consent of a legal guardian.
- 11 b. If disclosure of the electronic protected health
- 12 information to a legal guardian is otherwise prohibited
- 13 by state law or federal law, including federal statute,
- 14 regulation, or centers for disease control and prevention
- 15 quidelines.
- 16 2. For the purposes of this section:
- 17 a. "Disclosure" means the release, transfer, provision of
- 18 access to, or divulging in any manner of electronic protected
- 19 health information outside the entity holding the electronic
- 20 protected health information.
- 21 b. "Electronic media" means electronic storage material
- 22 on which data is or may be recorded electronically and
- 23 transmission media used to exchange information already in
- 24 electronic storage media.
- 25 c. "Electronic protected health information" means protected
- 26 health information that is transmitted or maintained by or in
- 27 electronic media.
- 28 d. "Facility" means a health care delivery system location
- 29 that provides a range of primary, secondary, and tertiary
- 30 inpatient, outpatient, and physician services; an institution
- 31 providing health care services; and any other health care
- 32 setting including but not limited to a hospital or other
- 33 licensed inpatient center, ambulatory surgical center
- 34 or treatment center, skilled nursing center, residential
- 35 treatment center, diagnostic, laboratory or imaging centers,

- 1 rehabilitation or other therapeutic health setting, or the
- 2 private office or clinic of an individual health care provider
- 3 or group of health care providers.
- 4 e. "Health care" means care, services, or supplies related
- 5 to the health of a person and includes but is not limited to:
- 6 (1) Preventive, diagnostic, therapeutic, rehabilitative,
- 7 maintenance, or palliative care, and any counseling, service,
- 8 assessment, or procedure with respect to the physical or mental
- 9 condition, or functional status of a person, or that affects
- 10 the structure or function of the body.
- ll (2) The sale or dispensing of a drug, device, equipment, or
- 12 other item in accordance with a prescription.
- 13 f. "Health care provider" means a physician or osteopathic
- 14 physician licensed under chapter 148, a physician assistant
- 15 licensed under chapter 148C, a podiatrist licensed under
- 16 chapter 149, a chiropractor licensed under chapter 151, a
- 17 licensed practical nurse, a registered nurse, or an advanced
- 18 registered nurse practitioner licensed under chapter 152 or
- 19 152E, a dentist licensed under chapter 153, an optometrist
- 20 licensed under chapter 154, a pharmacist licensed under chapter
- 21 155A, or any other person who is licensed, certified, or
- 22 otherwise authorized or permitted by the law of this state to
- 23 administer health care in the ordinary course of business or in
- 24 the practice of a profession.
- 25 q. "Health information" means health information as defined
- 26 in 45 C.F.R. §160.103 that is maintained or transmitted by a
- 27 health care provider or facility.
- 28 h. "Legal guardian" means a person appointed by a court as
- 29 the guardian of a minor pursuant to chapter 633, or the parent
- 30 or other person responsible for the care of the minor.
- 31 i. "Protected health information" means protected health
- 32 information as defined in 45 C.F.R. §160.103 that is maintained
- 33 or transmitted by a health care provider or facility.
- 34 EXPLANATION
- 35 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with

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- the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 2 This bill requires a health care provider or facility that
- 3 maintains or transmits electronic protected health information
- 4 (EPHI) to disclose to the legal guardian of a minor the minor's
- 5 EPHI, with some exceptions. The exceptions include that the
- 6 EPHI relates to health care for which the minor is legally
- 7 authorized to consent without the consent of a legal guardian;
- 8 or if disclosure of the EPHI to a legal guardian is otherwise
- 9 prohibited by state or federal law.
- 10 The bill provides definitions used in the bill including
- 11 "disclosure", "electronic media", "electronic protected
- 12 health information", "facility", "health care", "health
- 13 care provider", "health information", "legal guardian", and
- 14 "protected health information".
