- 1 Section 1. Section 256.11, subsection 5, paragraph b, Code
- 2 2024, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 b. Five units of the social studies including instruction
- 4 in voting statutes and procedures, voter registration
- 5 requirements, the use of paper ballots and voting systems in
- 6 the election process, and the method of acquiring and casting
- 7 an absentee ballot. All students shall complete a minimum
- 8 of one-half unit of United States government and one unit of
- 9 United States history. The one-half unit of United States
- 10 government shall include the all of the following:
- 11 (1) The voting procedure as described in this lettered
- 12 paragraph and section 280.9A. The government instruction shall
- 13 also include a
- 14 (2) A study of the Constitution of the United States and the
- 15 Bill of Rights contained in the Constitution and an assessment
- 16 of a student's knowledge of the Constitution and the Bill of
- 17 Rights.
- 18 (3) (a) A requirement that all students, as a condition of
- 19 graduation, articulate a written explanation demonstrating a
- 20 proficient understanding of all of the following:
- 21 (i) The great depression, including multiple schools of
- 22 economic thinking related to the great depression.
- 23 (ii) The holodomor, including historical evidence related
- 24 to communists orchestrating famine to starve political
- 25 opponents.
- 26 (iii) The definition and qualities of money, including
- 27 a history of money and credit in the United States and the
- 28 function and performance of the federal reserve system.
- 29 (b) This subparagraph shall not apply to a nonpublic school.
- 30 EXPLANATION
- 31 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 32 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 33 This bill modifies provisions related to the social studies
- 34 curriculum provided to students enrolled in school districts
- 35 in grades 9 through 12.

H.F. 2069

The bill provides that the one-half unit of United States government instruction that is provided to students enrolled in school districts in grades 9 through 12 as part of the social studies curriculum shall include a requirement that such students, as a condition of graduation, must articulate a written explanation demonstrating a proficient understanding of the great depression, the holodomor, and the definition and qualities of money.
